**Indecent Exposure \*ARREST** – On September 30, officers identified and obtained charges for the suspect sought in connection to the indecent exposure that was reported to have occurred in the 5500 block of Mapledale Plz in Woodbridge (22193) on September 27. The suspect, identified as Marvin Ismel **ESCOBAR MEDRANO**, was subsequently served with a court summons on October 1.

**Indecent Exposure [Previously Released]** – On September 27 at 2:43PM, officers responded to the 5500 block of Mapledale Plz in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate an indecent exposure. The investigation revealed the victim, a 35-year-old woman, was sitting in her vehicle in a parking lot in the above area when she was approached by an unknown man. During the encounter, the man exposed himself towards the victim and made inappropriate gestures before witnesses intervened and the man left the area on foot. No physical contact occurred, and no injuries were reported. Officers searched the area for the suspect who was not located.

## Incidents

**Homicide Investigation** – On October 2 at 10:48PM, officers responded to Stonebridge at Potomac Town Center located in the 15200 block of Potomac Town Pl in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a shooting. When officers arrived in the area, two men were located with gunshot injuries. The initial investigation revealed one of the injured parties, identified as a 21-year-old man, had been shot multiple times outside of the Alamo Drafthouse during an encounter with another individual. Officers located the victim on the sidewalk near the location where first aid was provided. Fire & rescue personnel responded to further treat the victim who ultimately succumbed to his injuries. Additionally, an 18-year-old man sustained a non-life threatening grazed wound to the lower body during the encounter. The suspect reportedly left the area immediately after the shooting and was not located. **Preliminarily, this incident does not appear random. Detectives are asking anyone with any information, or anyone who may have witnessed the incident, to contact police.** Additional information will be released when available. The investigation continues.

**Reckless Handling of a Firearm** – On October 2 at 7:47AM, officers responded to Davenport Insulation located at 7400 Gateway Ct in Manassas (20109) to investigate a destruction of property. The investigation revealed sometime between September 25 and October 1, an exterior window to the building was struck by a bullet. The projectile did not penetrate into the business. No injuries or other property damage were reported.
