

Keith Tignor, our State Apiarist, will cover the steps needed to winterize your beehives. The workshop will include a PowerPoint presentation in the large conference room at the Randolph Farm Pavilion on the main subject

matter. The hands-on portion will include a visit bee yard on Randolph Farm. Topics will include opening a hive for inspection, pest identification and management, techniques to feed bees over the winter, cover crops to support your bees and tree species that produce the most nectar and pollen. The workshop will also cover when and how to order honeybee nucs in preparation for the spring. Information from this program will help attendees mitigate hive loss over the winter.

All participants should bring a bee suit to wear during the hive inspection part of this workshop. Wear light-colored clothes and avoid open-toe shoes, perfume or cologne. Coffee and donuts will be provided.

#### **VIRGINIA ACTS TO PROTECT SNAP RECIPIENTS**

Governor Youngkin launches emergency state-funded food assistance amid federal shutdown

#### VIRGINIA EMERGENCY NUTRITION ASSISTANCE (VENA)

- Uses the same EBT cards and same beneficiaries as SNAP.
- Funded by Virginia's state budget surplus—no federal funds.
- Delivers weekly benefits instead of monthly (approximately ¼ of monthly amount each week).
- \$37.5 million per week in benefits to support Virginians in need.

  Additional \$1 million directed to Virginia's food bank network to ease the transition and help families facing hardship.

#### LEARN MORE



To offset the freeze of the federal SNAP program, Virginia will be rolling out a parallel food assistance program, Virginia Emergency VIRGINIA FOOD BANKS Nutrition Assistance (VENA), which distributes surplus dollars from the

state budget. Virginia SNAP beneficiaries will receive the state funds directly to their EBT cards. There may be some delays in the process.
