
PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Route 1 (Richmond Highway) corridor is an important north-south principal arterial providing connection within Prince William County between Woodbridge to the north and Dumfries to the south. This study will provide an analysis for the Route 1 corridor from Neabsco Road / Cardinal Drive to Route (234) to identify operational and safety issues; and to develop improvement alternatives that will address these issues and the regional transportation needs. This section of Route 1 is 2.7 miles in length, which includes ten (10) signalized intersections, and several unsignalized intersections and access points. The study location is shown in **Figure 1**.



The purpose of this study is to evaluate vehicular traffic operations and safety, safety conditions for bicycle, pedestrian and transit, and to develop improvement alternatives. Based on the operational and safety analysis for the existing and future nobuild conditions, improvement alternatives will be developed. The intent of the alternative development is to focus on the intersections along the corridor that involves widening.

Ultimately, the findings and recommendations from this study will not only support immediate operational and safety enhancements but also provide a foundation for long-term planning and potential funding applications aimed at further developing the Route 1 corridor. By fostering a holistic approach—balancing mobility, safety,

community needs, and environmental stewardship—the project aspires to create a safer, more efficient, and more vibrant transportation corridor for all users.

The purpose of this public meeting is to share information and gather input on the traffic study.
