Alumni Spot Light Kelli Garrett

Kelli competed in livestock skillathon, meat judging, livestock judging, as well as exhibited sheep at the local, state and national level as a 4-Her and FFA member. Kelli completed her youth animal science career in 2024,



when she aged out of the program and began her collegiate career at Kansas State University. Kelli says "I chose to attend Kansas State University because of the top-tier education I would receive as an animal science student."

Kelli is currently a senior at Kansas State University majoring in Animal Science with a minor in Food Science. Kelli has been very involved as a student in the College of Agriculture at K-State through her involvement as a member of the Agriculture Ambassadors, Meet Judging Team, Meat Science Quiz bowl and an undergraduate research assistant within the Meat Science Department.

While Kelli has had numerous note worthy accomplishments both as a youth in the Virginia Youth Animal Science programs as well as a collegiate competitor on numer-

ous teams; her most recent was being named high individual overall at the American Royal Meat Judging Contest. The Kansas State University Meat Judging Team, which Kelli is a member of, received Reserve Champion Team title at the American Royal Meat Judging Contest, as well.

After graduation in May, Kelli will be staying at K-State to pursue her master's degree in Meat Science. During that time, Kelli will also be the 2027 Assistant Meat Judging Team Coach.
