

The Prince William County Department of Transportation (PWCDOT) will conduct a Public Hearing for the Rollins Ford Road Roundabout Project at the Glenkirk Elementary School Cafeteria at 8584 Sedge Wren Dr, Gainesville, VA 20155, doors will be open at 6:00 p.m. and the presentation starts at 6:30 pm, the meeting will be concluded at 8:00 p.m. on Thursday, January 29, 2026. Prince William County representatives and consultant design staff will be present to discuss the project, answer questions, and receive input on the proposed designs for roadway improvements.



The Rollins Ford Road Roundabout Project involves the design and construction of two single-lane roundabouts at the intersections of Rollins Ford Road and Song Sparrow / Yellow Hammer Drive, and Rollins Ford Road and Estate Manor Drive. The proposed improvements would also reconfigure Rollins Ford Road between Song Sparrow / Yellow Hammer Drive and Estate Manor Drive from two lanes in each direction to one lane in each direction, with the existing outside lane removed through pavement striping.
