### Incidents

**Armed Robbery | Reckless Handling of a Firearm** – On December 20 at 4:26PM, officers responded to Dumfries Shopping Center located in the 18000 block of Dumfries Shopping Plz in Dumfries (22026) to investigate a robbery. The investigation revealed the victim, a 21-year-old man, arranged to sell clothing items through the “Offer Up” app to an unknown party at the above shopping center. Once in the area, the victim met with two men accompanied by two women. During the encounter, one of the men reached into the victim’s vehicle and grabbed the clothing items from the victim. The victim drove off, at which point one of the suspects fired a handgun towards the victim’s vehicle which penetrated through the back glass and struck the vehicle’s front console. No injuries or other property damage were reported. The two suspects were described as black males, both in their late teens to early 20s and approximately 6’0”.

**Reckless Handling of a Firearm** – On December 21 at 6:44PM, officers responded to the area of Botsford Rd and Forrester Ln in Manassas (20109) to investigate a shots fired call. The investigation revealed the victims, a 20-year-old man and a 25-year-old man, were sitting in a vehicle in the above area when another vehicle pulled up to theirs where an occupant inside began firing towards them. All parties dispersed prior to officers arriving on the scene. The two victims contacted police later in the evening to report the incident. The victim’s vehicle and a home in the area were damaged by gunfire. Shell casings were also found on the roadway. No injuries or other property damage were reported. **This incident does not appear to be random.**

**Reckless Handling of a Firearm** – On December 19, officers responded to investigate a shots fired call that was reported to have occurred in the 13800 block of Meadowbrook Rd in Woodbridge (22193) on December 14 at approximately 4:40AM. The investigation revealed a homeowner located damage to their residence which was believed to have been caused by gunfire. The homeowner reported hearing gunshots earlier in the week. A neighbor’s unoccupied vehicle was also struck during the same incident. No injuries or other property damage were reported. **This incident does not appear to be random.**

**Attempted Residential Burglary** – On December 19 at 6:55PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 8200 block of Roxborough Lp in Gainesville (20155) to investigate an attempted burglary. The investigation revealed sometime overnight, entry was attempted into the residence through a rear door that was found damaged. No entry was made into the home, and no property was reported missing.

## Arrests

**Strong-Arm Robbery** – On December 21 at 10:14PM, officers responded to Juniors Market located at 13309 Occoquan Rd in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a robbery. The investigation revealed an unknown man, later identified as the accused, attempted to take several items and leave the store. At one point, the accused made verbal threats towards the employees before walking out of the business. No injuries were reported. The accused was subsequently detained by arriving officers without incident. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Francisco **OLMNA**, was arrested.
