### Incidents

**Reckless Handling of a Firearm** – On December 27 at 9:20PM, officers responded to the area of Clipper Dr and Mariner Ln in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a road rage incident. The investigation revealed the victim, a 29-year-old man, was driving in the above area when he encountered the driver of another vehicle described as a dark-colored pickup truck, possibly a Chevrolet, with an extended cab. At one point during the encounter, the driver stopped their vehicle in front of the victim. As the victim attempted to drive away, gunshots were heard. The victim left the area and contacted police. The victim's vehicle was struck twice, and shell casings were located in the roadway where the incident was reported to have taken place. No injuries or other property damage were reported. The suspect vehicle was reportedly occupied by five men, no other descriptions were provided.

### Arrests

**Assault & Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]** – On December 27 at 11:56PM, officers responded to the area of Linton Hall Rd and Bridlewood Dr in Bristow (20136) to investigate a crash. During the investigation, one of the drivers, later identified as the accused, was determined to be intoxicated and was subsequently detained. At one point while in custody, the accused became combative and kneed an officer to the lower body. The officer was not injured. The driver of the other vehicle involved in the crash, a 54-year-old man, was treated at an area hospital. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Tinoosh **MALEKI**, was arrested.
