 - Documentation from the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs stating that the veteran had a service-connected disability, which was 100% (or compensated at the 100% rate), permanent and total.
 - A copy of the veteran's death certificate.
- For Surviving Spouses of Members of the U.S. Armed Forces who died in the line of duty:
 - Documentation from the U.S. Department of Defense indicating the date the member of the U.S. armed forces died in the line of duty.
- For Surviving Spouses of certain persons killed in the line of duty:
 - Documentation from the Virginia Retirement System or from the State Comptroller for the Virginia Department of Accounts stating that you are the spouse and the beneficiary of death-in-service benefits of an eligible person killed in the line of duty.
