

Incidents

Attempted Residential Burglary – On January 28 at 9:10PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 8100 block of Spruce St in Manassas (20111) to investigate an attempted burglary. The investigation revealed entry was attempted into the home through a rear door. The suspect ran from the area when observed by the homeowner. No entry was made into the residence, and no property was reported missing. A police K-9 searched the area for the suspect who was not located. The suspect was described as a male, unknown race, between 20-30 years old, 5'6" with black hair wearing a white jacket and dark-colored boots.

Arrests

Reckless Handling & Brandishing of a Firearm – On January 28 at 4:16PM, officers responded to the 7500 block of Gales Ct in Manassas (20109) to investigate a crash. The investigation revealed one of the drivers, later identified as the accused, was involved in a vehicle collision with another driver. During the encounter, the accused brandished a firearm before leaving the scene. A short time later, the accused arrived at an area hospital with a self-inflicted gunshot wound to the lower body from an apparent accidental discharge after the above encounter. The injury was determined to be non-life threatening, and the accused was treated before being taken into custody by officers. A firearm was also recovered from the vehicle. The other driver involved in the initial collision was not injured. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Kyle Tor **CROSKEY**, was arrested. While in custody, the accused made threatening statements towards officers. Additional charges were obtained.
