**WHEREAS**, citizens of Prince William County have ranked environmental programs and open space very high in the 2002 Park Authority Needs Assessment; and

**WHEREAS**, the Prince William County Community Services Board offers a Horticultural Therapy program to the residents of Prince William County; and

**WHEREAS**, Horticultural Therapy program has been permanently displaced from its Grayson Gardens location and desires to partner with the Park Authority to develop a Horticultural Center for Prince William County; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Park Authority owns a 17.95 acre parcel of land on Bristow Road (GPIN 7792-82-7212) known as Shenandoah Park that is not currently Masterplanned; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Park Authority desires to partner with the Horticultural Therapy program to develop a Horticultural/Environmental Center; and,

**WHEREAS**, Shenandoah Park has been identified by Park Authority and Community Services Board staff as an ideal location for a Horticultural/Environmental Center; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Park Authority has conducted a public hearing to accept public comment prior to adopting a new Masterplan;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Prince William County Park Authority Board does hereby adopt the Shenandoah Park Masterplan..
