Arrests

Aggravated Malicious Wounding – On February 6 at 11:50PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 13900 block of Richmond Hwy in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a stabbing. The investigation revealed the victim, a 53-year-old man, and an acquaintance, identified as the accused, were involved in a verbal argument that escalated. During the encounter, the victim was stabbed in the abdomen. The victim was treated at an area hospital for non-life-threatening injuries. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Adilson Alexander **BAIDES-PEREZ**, was arrested.



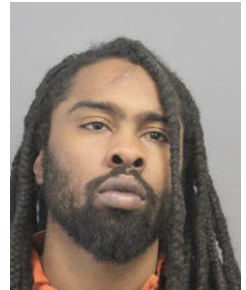
Arrested on February 8:

Charged with *aggravated malicious wounding*

Assault on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO] – On February 4 at 10:30PM, officers were in the area of the Red Roof Inn located at 17113 Dumfries Rd in Dumfries (22025) and observed a vehicle in the parking lot engaged in drug activity. As officers were speaking with the occupants, drug paraphernalia was observed. When officers attempted to detain the individuals, one of the passengers, identified as the accused, assaulted an officer. The accused then attempted to flee on foot from the officers before quickly being taken into custody. No injuries were reported. Following the investigation, the accused identified as Larry Lequan James **SCOTT**, was arrested.

Charged with *assault and battery on LEO, possession with intent to distribute a controlled substance, obstruction of justice* and *contributing to the delinquency of a minor*.
