Incidents

Fatal Crash Investigation – On February 17 at 6:06PM, officers responded to the area of Richmond Hwy and Opitz Blvd in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a crash involving a pedestrian. The investigation revealed the pedestrian, identified as a 70-year-old man, was walking in the roadway, across Richmond Hwy when he was struck by a passing motorist driving a 2025 Toyota Camry that was traveling south. At the time of the crash, the pedestrian was not in a designated crosswalk or safe crossing area. The driver of the Toyota, identified as a 19-year-old man, stayed at the scene and was not injured. The pedestrian was transported to an area hospital where he later died. **Crash investigators are asking anyone who may have witnessed this crash to contact police.**

Vandalism – On February 17 at 2:00PM, officers responded to a commercial building located in the 16700 block of River Ridge Blvd in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a vandalism. The investigation revealed between January 26 and February 16, swastikas, racial slurs and other symbols were spray painted inside the commercial building, which is currently under construction. No suspect(s) information was provided.

Arrests

Burglary- On February 17 at 5:38PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 18300 block of Chestnut Dr in Triangle (22172) to investigate a burglary. The investigation revealed an unknown man, later identified as the accused, was armed with a knife and entered the residence where he then assaulted the victim, identified as a 62-year-old man. Officers quickly detained the accused without incident. No injuries were reported. The accused was treated at an area hospital and released. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Dominique Jerome **COOPER**, was arrested.

Assault on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]- On February 17 at 10:31PM, officers responded to the Molinari Juvenile Shelter located at 8642 Wellington Rd in Manassas (20109) to investigate an assault. The investigation revealed the accused, a **13-year-old female juvenile**, had assaulted a staff member. Officers quickly detained the accused and while placing her inside a police cruiser, she became aggressive and kicked multiple officers several times before being detained. The accused was treated at an area hospital and later released. While at the hospital, the accused assaulted officers again and then continued to be aggressive and kicked an officer as she was being escorted into the Juvenile Detention Center.. Minor injuries were reported by the officers. Following the investigation, the accused was arrested.

Possession of a Weapon on School Grounds – On February 12 at 9:45AM, the School Resource Officer (SRO) at Potomac Shores Middle School located at 17851 Woods View Dr in Dumfries (22026) was notified of a student who was found in possession of a knife. The investigation revealed security staff had recovered the knife and notified the SRO. The student did not threaten other students or staff or display the knife. Following the investigation, the student, identified as a **13-year-old male juvenile**, was charged.
