Incidents

Murder/Suicide Investigation- On February 21 at 8:05AM, officers responded to a residence located in the 3400 block of Vale Ct in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a stabbing. Officers arrived on scene and located four deceased individuals inside the home, including a small child. The presumed suspect, preliminarily identified as an adult woman, and two other adult family members, a man and woman, were also among the deceased. Autopsies conducted confirmed all parties died from knife-related injuries. The suspected murder weapon was recovered. The incident was contained inside the home and there was no active threat to the surrounding community. More information regarding this investigation will be released if deemed necessary.

Identified:

The deceased were identified as a **69-year-old woman, 40-year-old man, 35-year-old woman,** and a **2-year-old boy**, all of Woodbridge

Death Investigation- On February 21 at 9:56AM, officers responded to a residence located in the 13900 block of Aden Rd in Nokesville (20181) for a report of a man trapped under a vehicle. The investigation revealed the deceased, identified as a 21-year-old man, was changing the oil of his vehicle, a 2016 Volvo tractor truck, when the vehicle rolled forward and pinned him underneath. The man was pronounced dead on scene. Preliminarily, there were no signs of foul play concerning the death. More information regarding the investigation will be released if deemed necessary.

Death Investigation- On February 20 at 4:39AM, officers responded to the area of Lee Hwy and Sudley Rd in Manassas (20109) to investigate a report of a person in crisis. The investigation revealed the deceased, identified as a 23-year-old man, was located in his vehicle on the side of Lee Hwy. The man was pronounced dead on scene. Preliminarily, there were no signs of foul play concerning the death. More information regarding the investigation will be released if deemed necessary.

Armed Robbery- On February 23 at 12:56AM, officers responded to the Sunoco gas station, located at 1260 Annapolis Wy in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate an armed robbery. The investigation revealed the victims, a 27-year-old man and a 25-year-old woman, were in their vehicle at the gas pumps when they were approached by two unknown men driving a dark-colored SUV. During the encounter, the men exited the vehicle, brandished firearms at the victims and demanded their belongings before leaving the area in the SUV. No injuries were reported.

Suspect descriptions:

Black male, mid to late 20's, with an afro hairstyle

Black male, mid to late 20's, light complexioned, with a tattoo over the right eyebrow

Strong-Armed Robbery- On February 21 at 9:06PM, officers responded to Oakley Vault inside Potomac Mills located at 2700 Potomac Mills Cir in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a robbery. The investigation revealed an unknown man entered the store and took four pairs of sunglasses. As the suspect was leaving the store, he attempted to assault an employee. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a black male wearing a black and white varsity jacket, blue jeans, glasses and a black "NY" hat.

Brandishing a Firearm- On February 20 at 11:42PM, officers responded to the intersection of Williamson Blvd and Sudley Manor Dr in Manassas (20109) to investigate brandishing. The investigation revealed the victim, a 29-year-old man, was driving in the area when he saw an unknown man walking in the roadway. The man had a firearm in his hand and pointed the firearm toward the victim who was driving past the intersection. No injuries were reported and no shots were fired. The suspect was described as a white male, wearing a dark brown hoodie and dark colored pants.

Attempted Burglary- On February 21 at 7:48PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 8200 block of Handsome Joe Ln in Manassas (20111) to investigate an attempted burglary. The investigation revealed the homeowner heard someone kicking his front door multiple times. No entry was made into the residence and no damage to property was reported. The suspect was described as a male wearing a gray hoodie, white sweatpants, white shoes and a black ski mask.
