Incidents

Shooting Investigation- On February 23 at 6:30PM, officers responded to the Market at Opitz Crossing shopping center located in the 1900 block of Daniel Stuart Sq in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a shooting. The investigation revealed an exchange of gunfire occurred in the parking lot between a 22-year-old man and a second unknown man. During the encounter, the 22-year-old man sustained a gunshot wound to the upper body and was transported to an area hospital where the injury was determined to be non-life-threatening. The other party left the scene following the shooting and was not located. No other injuries or property damage were reported. **This incident does not appear to be random.**

Robbery- On February 20 at 11:33AM, officers responded to BJ's Wholesale Club located at 14123 Noblewood Plz in Woodbridge (22193) for a report of a shoplifter. The investigation revealed two unknown men, later identified as the two accused, were exiting the store with unpaid merchandise when one of the men sprayed an eye irritant into the store before leaving the area in a vehicle. Multiple people inside the business experienced symptoms and were treated at the scene by medical personnel while one person was treated at an area hospital for a non-life-threatening reaction. Following the investigation, detectives obtained arrest warrants for both men, identified as Rodney **JOHNSON** and Jhonathan Moises **UGALDE RAMOS**. On February 24, Jhonathan Moises **UGALDE RAMOS** was arrested. Attempts to locate Rodney **JOHNSON** were unsuccessful.

Arrests

Destruction of Property | Unlawful Entry- On February 17, 2026, detectives concluded an investigation into extensive vandalism that was reported to have occurred at the Impact Church located at 15505 Neabsco Mills Rd in Woodbridge (22191) sometime between December 21, 2025, and January 2, 2026. The investigation revealed sometime between the above timeframe, over 200 windows were broken or otherwise damaged. In addition to windows, multiple doors to the church were damaged and graffiti was spray painted throughout the interior and exterior of the building. Total damage done to the building was estimated to be over \$300,000. During the course of the investigation, detectives were able to identify a suspect and obtain juvenile petitions. Following the investigation the accused, identified as a **16-year-old male juvenile** of Lorton, was charged. The investigation continues into the identities of other suspects involved in the incident.
