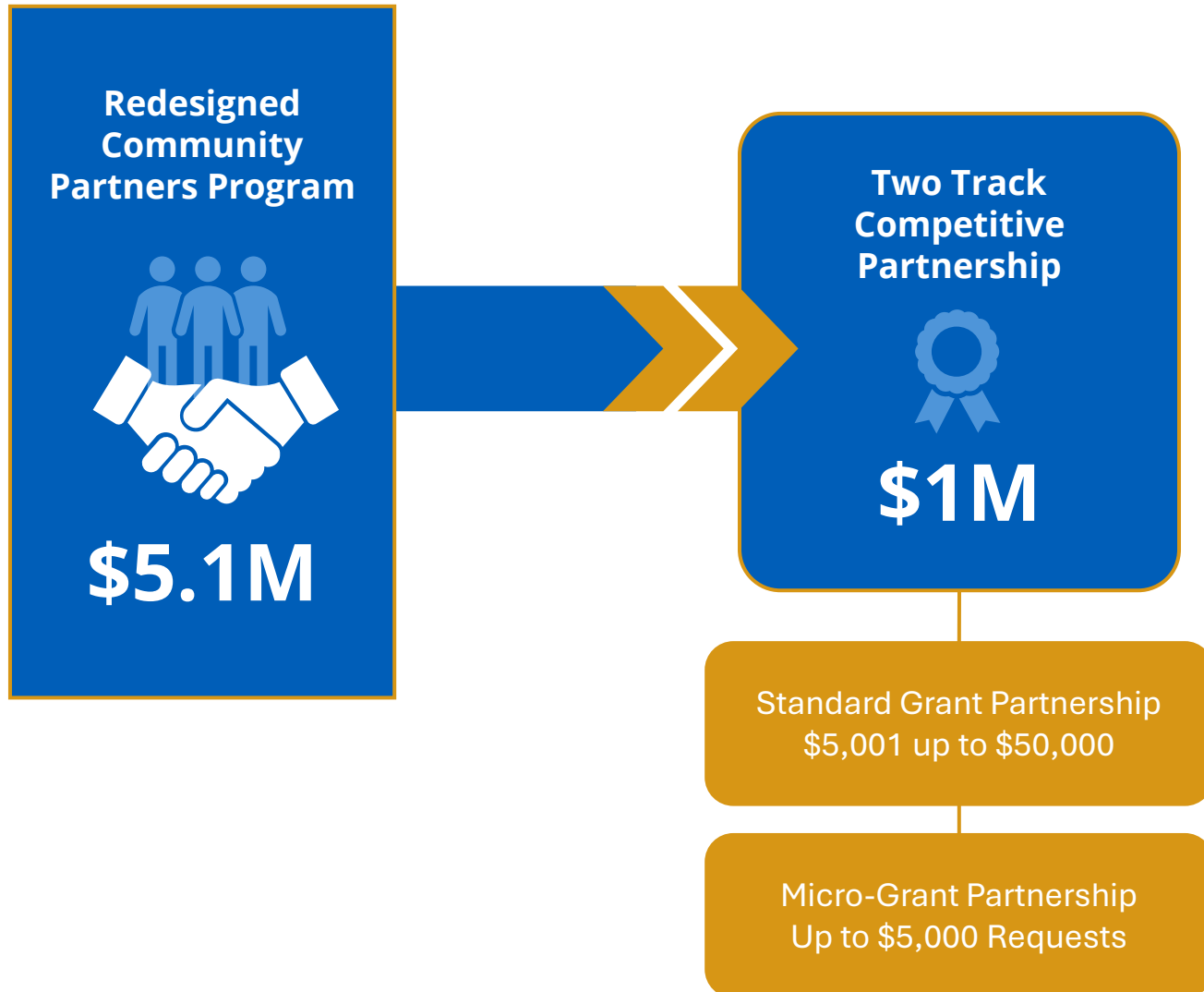

# Competitive Community Partners Process



## New in FY27

- Standard funding request is now **\$50,000**
- In the County's proposed budget there is additional funding of \$425K for Competitive Community Partners Program budget raising the budget amount to **\$1M**
  - Adoption of the Budget is April 21<sup>st</sup>

# Competitive Community Partners Process

- Basics of the competitive process
  - Select the Standard or Micro application located the Community Partners website
  - The scoring rubric will be used for both Standard and Micro funding requests
  - Application deadline is the same for both Standard and Micro funding requests
- Standard Community Partners application information
  - Funding requests up to **\$50,000**
  - Eligibility Criteria: non-profit 501(C)3 organization that provides specific services, and
    - Has been in existence for at least 3 years
    - Has an identifiable Executive Director
    - Has an identifiable Board of Directors
    - Cannot be controlled in whole or in part by any church or sectarian society, per VA Code 15.2-953
  - Non-Profit Organizations will provide three (3) years of tax information (IRS 990s)
  - Along with current financial statement – compiled or audited

# Competitive Community Partners Process Continued

- Micro Community Partners application information
  - Funding requests up to \$5,000
  - Eligibility Criteria: non-profit 501(C)3 organization that provides specific services, and
    - Has been in existence for at least 1 year
    - Has an identifiable Executive Director
    - Has an identifiable Board of Directors
    - Cannot be controlled in whole or in part by any church or sectarian society, per VA Code 15.2-953
  - Non-Profit Organizations will provide one (1) year of tax information (IRS 990s)
  - Along with current financial statement – compiled or audited
- Micro Partnerships are meant for newer organizations that might not have hit the three (3) year non-profit status for the Standard Partnership

- Board of Directors
  - It is okay if the Non-Profit has more than 5 Directors
- Where can the Team validate the information
  - The dropdown has 2 choices, Taxes or Other, which will then open a new box to specify where the Team will find the information
- Two questions
  - First should be *Yes* because the Non-Profit read the beginning criteria from Slide 8
  - The second draw a *No* 90% of the time, but if it is a *Yes*, a new box will open for the Non-Profit to supply more information

  - This should be a concise statement of the program or service
    - Example: The Non-Profit will help assist with the adoption of animals at the shelter
- Non-Profit's Mission Statement
- Briefly describe the purpose of the funding request
  - This is where the Non-Profit provides detail about the program or service
  - It should be concise, so the Selection Committee understands what and how the program or service is being provided
- Lastly, how the program or service links back to the County's 2025-2028 Strategic Plan
  - There is a link to the Strategic Plan that will open in a separate internet window


## Just a quick tip

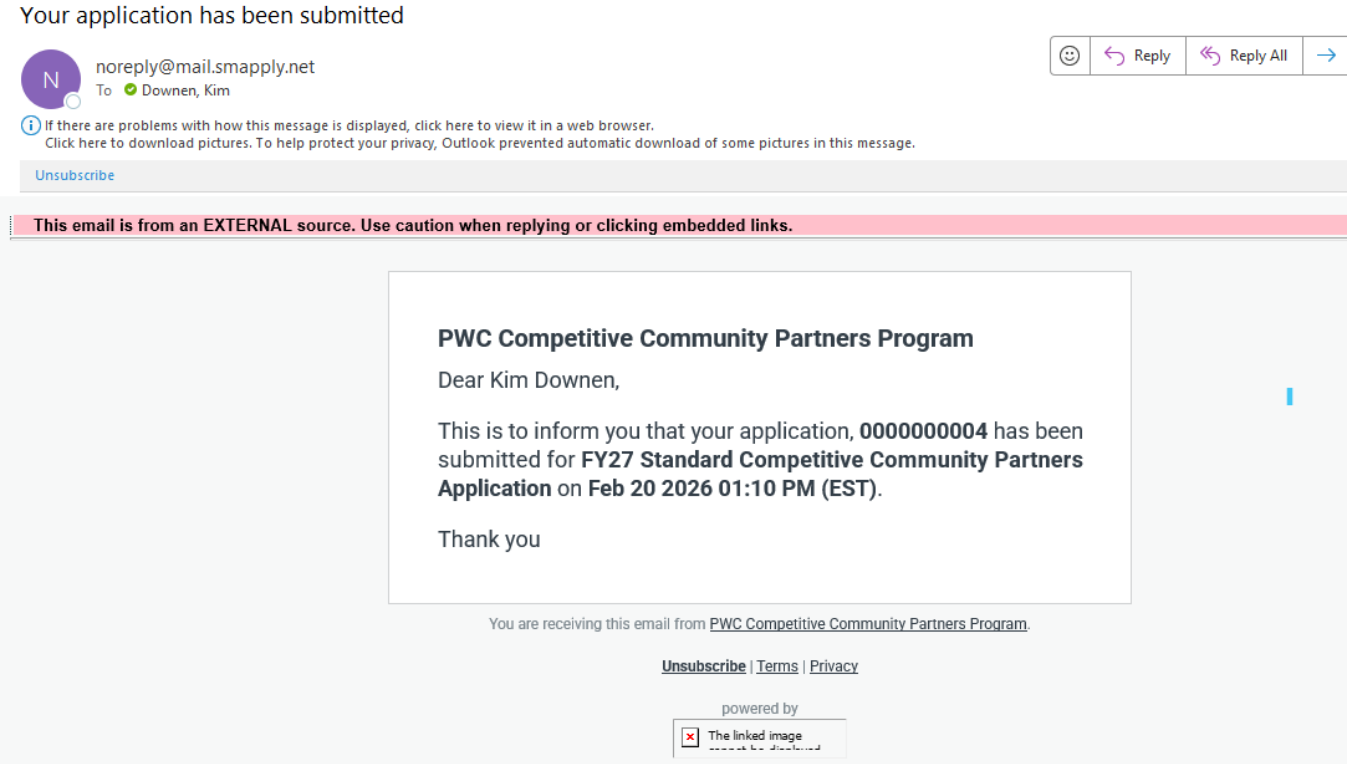


