Incidents

Fatal Crash Investigation - On February 28 at 2:53PM, officers responded to the area of Sudley Road and Campus Drive in Manassas (20109) to investigate a fatal crash. The investigation revealed the driver of a 2019 Toyota Camry was traveling northbound on Sudley Road at a high rate of speed, while passing a vehicle. At one point, the vehicle struck a concrete median and was redirected into oncoming traffic, striking a 2017 Honda CRV head-on. The driver of the Toyota, identified as a 74-year-old woman, was transported to an area hospital where she later died. The driver of the Honda CRV, identified as a 63-year-old man and two passengers, identified as a 23-year-old female and 19-year-old female, were transported to area hospitals with serious injuries. **Crash investigators are asking anyone who may have witnessed this crash to contact police.**

Strong-Arm Robbery- On March 1 at 5:30PM, officers responded to the 7-Eleven located at 7500 Cushing Rd in Manassas (20109) to investigate a robbery. The investigation revealed an unknown man approached the service counter and provided the employee with a note demanding money and threatening an assault. The employee complied with the note, and the suspect left the area on foot. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a white male, 6'0", wearing a black Puma hoodie with white lettering, blue jeans, brown boots and a black beanie hat.

Strong-Arm Robbery- On February 27, officers responded to investigate a robbery that was reported to have occurred at the 7-Eleven located at 1701 Featherstone Road in Woodbridge (22191) on February 26 at approx. 10:00PM. The investigation revealed the victim, a 44-year-old man, was approached in the parking lot by two unknown men. During the encounter, one of the suspects asked the victim for money and when the victim refused, the suspects assaulted him and took his belongings before leaving the area on foot. Minor injuries were reported by the victim. The suspects were described as two Hispanic men, with one suspect described as wearing a light gray hoodie, dark gray jacket, gray sweatpants, white sneakers and a black baseball hat with a red logo.

Commercial Burglary- On March 2 at 1:54AM, officers responded to Field Six, located at 13895 Hedgewood Dr in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a burglary. The investigation revealed an unknown man broke a window and entered into the business. Various merchandise was reported missing and multiple items inside the business were damaged. The suspect was described as a black male, 18-20 years old, wearing a black hoodie, gray sweatpants and a black face mask.

Residential Burglary- On February 26, officers responded to a residence located in the 3800 block of Appaloosa Dr in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a burglary. The investigation revealed between 7:15AM and 4:45PM, the residence was entered and multiple rooms were rummaged through. No property damage was reported, and no items were reported missing. No suspect information was available.

Arrests

Aggravated Malicious Wounding- On February 21 at 7:15PM, officers responded to the 15900 block of Donald Curtis Dr on Woodbridge (22191) to investigate an assault. The investigation revealed the victim, a 29-year-old man, was at the bus stop when he was assaulted by three unknown men, two of which were later identified as the two accused. The victim was transported to an area hospital with serious, non-life-threatening injuries. Following the investigation, officers obtained arrest warrants for the two accused, identified as Deashon Thomas **CLARK** and Ezekiel **COOPER** III. On February 21, Deashon Thomas **CLARK** was arrested. Attempts to locate Ezekiel **COOPER** III were unsuccessful.
