### Updates

**Murder Investigation \*ARREST-** On March 2, the suspect sought in connection to the murder of a 34-year-old Alexandria man in the parking lot of Potomac Mills located at 2700 Potomac Mills Cir in Woodbridge (22192) on February 24, was arrested. The investigation revealed the suspect, identified as Clifton Joseph **DOUGLAS**, had arrived at the location with another man, identified as Beau Wade **BISHOP**, to meet the victim. At one point, **DOUGLAS** got into the victim's vehicle where an altercation ensued, and the victim was subsequently shot. After the shooting, **DOUGLAS** rejoined **BISHOP** and left the area in their vehicle. Officers located the suspect vehicle outside of **BISHOP'S** home in Woodbridge where he was arrested without incident on February 27. On March 1, detectives identified the shooter in the incident as **DOUGLAS** and obtained arrest warrants. Members of the U.S. Marshals Task Force located **DOUGLAS** in Chesterfield County where he was arrested on March 2.

**Murder Investigation [Previously Released]** - On February 24 at 7:09PM, officers responded to the parking lot of Potomac Mills, located at 2700 Potomac Mills Cir in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a shooting. When officers arrived in the area, they located one man with gunshot injuries. The investigation revealed the victim, a 34-year-old man, sustained a gunshot wound to the upper body during an altercation with another man inside a vehicle that was parked in the parking lot. The injured party exited the vehicle and collapsed. Arriving officers performed first aid until the man was transported to an area hospital where he later succumbed to his injuries. The suspect left the area in a separate vehicle and was not immediately located. **Preliminarily, this incident does not appear random.** Detectives are asking anyone with any information, or anyone who may have witnessed the incident, to contact police. Additional information will be released when available.

## Incidents

**Strong-Armed Robbery-** On March 2 at 6:57PM, officers responded to a parking lot located in the 1800 block of Horner Rd in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a robbery. The investigation revealed the victim, a 42-year-old male, was selling his iPhone on Facebook Marketplace and arranged to meet a prospective buyer at the location to complete the transaction. While the victim was in the parking lot, two unknown men approached him and requested to see his phone. The victim refused and the suspects grabbed the phone from his hands and left the area on foot. No injuries were reported. The suspects were described a black male wearing dark-colored clothing and a Hispanic male wearing dark-colored clothing.
