### Incidents

**Fatal Crash Investigation** – On March 8 at 6:45PM, officers responded to the intersection of Cardinal Dr and Whips Run Dr in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a multi-vehicle crash. The investigation revealed the driver of a 2015 Hyundai Genesis was traveling the wrong way in the eastbound lanes of Cardinal Dr, approaching Whips Run Dr when it struck a 2024 Hyundai Santa Fe that was traveling eastbound, in a head-on collision. The force of the impact caused the Hyundai Santa Fe to collide with a 2025 GMC Hummer that was also traveling eastbound on Cardinal Dr. Debris from the crash struck an unoccupied 2024 Honda Accord parked in a nearby driveway on Whips Run Dr. The driver of the Hyundai Genesis, identified as a 27-year-old woman, was transported to an area hospital with life-threatening injuries. The driver and passenger of the Hyundai Santa Fe, identified as a 40-year-old woman and 42-year-old man, were also transported to an area hospital, where they were both pronounced deceased. No injuries were reported by the driver of the GMC Hummer, identified as a 23-year-old man. **Crash investigators are asking anyone who may have witnessed this crash to contact police.**

**Reckless Handling of a Firearm Incidents-** On March 6 at 1:37PM, officers responded to the area of Rylstone Ln and Sweeney Ln in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a shots fired call. The investigation revealed the victims, a 38-year-old man and two juveniles, were inside their vehicle when a black SUV approached. During the encounter, an unknown man exited the SUV and fired multiple gunshots towards the victim's vehicle before leaving the area. One shell casing was located in the roadway. The suspect was described as a black male, in his late 20's or early 30's. This incident is believed to be related to two additional property damage calls that were reported on March 7. The investigation into those incidents revealed two separate nearby homes, one in the 16800 block of Sweeney Ln and the other in the 2500 block of Miranda Ct, were struck by gunfire possibly related to the previous reported incident on March 6. No injuries were reported in any of the incidents.

**Attempted Residential Burglaries-** On March 8 at approximately 1:00AM, officers responded to two separate residences located in the 13900 block of Walton Dr in Manassas (22112) to investigate attempted burglaries. The investigation revealed the glass pane to the garage door to one of the homes had been shattered. In the second instance, three unknown male juveniles approached and kicked the front door to the residence multiple times before leaving the area in a dark-colored SUV. No entry was made into either home, and no property was reported missing.

### ***Suspect Descriptions:***

Three male teenagers, 15–17 years of age, one was last seen wearing a white t-shirt and black shorts, another wore a dark-colored t-shirt and sweatpants, and the third had on a black t-shirt, black sweatpants and black shoes

## Arrests

**Assault & Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]-** On March 6 at 4:13PM, officers responded to The Harbour Grille, located at 13188 Marina Way in Woodbridge (22191) for a report of a disorderly individual. Once on scene, officers located the woman, later identified as the accused, and trespassed her from the property at the request of the business. After receiving the trespassing paperwork, the accused became aggressive and assaulted an officer, before being detained. No injuries were reported. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Bernice **ODURO**, was arrested.
