### Updates

**Murder Investigation \*ARREST | WANTED SUSPECT** - Detectives have obtained multiple arrest warrants in connection to the ongoing investigation into the 18-year-old man who was killed during a shooting that occurred in the 1800 block of Potomac Shores Pkwy in Dumfries (22026) on March 9. A search warrant was also executed at the home of the suspect in Gainesville. During the search warrant, and attempted service of the arrest warrants, the accused, identified as J'Shaun Zomari **WILLIAMS**, was not located. Anyone with information on the whereabouts of this individual is asked to contact the Prince William County Police Department. Additionally, detectives obtained charges against one of the injured juveniles involved in the incident. The juvenile has since been released from the hospital and is in custody. Additional details regarding this incident will be released when available. The investigation continues.

*\*Continuation of the investigative update from the previous page*

**Murder Investigation [Previously Released]** – On March 9 at 5:33PM, officers responded to an outdoor recreational area located in the 1800 block of Potomac Shores Pkwy in Dumfries (22026) to investigate a shooting. The investigation revealed several individuals were playing basketball on the courts nearby when another group arrived. During the encounter, a confrontation ensued between the arriving group and some of the individuals previously on the courts. At one point, gunfire was exchanged which caused everyone to disperse the area. Officers arrived at the scene quickly and located an individual with a gunshot wound. As the investigation progressed, another individual was located at a nearby home on Spring Cress Dr, while three other individuals had self-transported to different hospitals in the area where they were determined to be connected to the incident. In total, five males between 16-20 years of age were shot. One of the individuals, an 18-year-old man, succumbed to his injuries at the hospital. The remaining injured parties are expected to recover. Several witnesses and other possibly involved individuals were initially detained. Detectives are still sorting through who had what involvement in the encounter, and what led up to the shooting. Preliminarily, this incident does not appear to be random. Additional details will be released when available. Detectives encourage anyone who may have witnessed this incident, or have information to aid in the investigation, to contact the Prince William County Police Department. The investigation continues. Identified: The deceased was identified as an 18-year-old man of Dumfries. The injured parties were preliminarily identified as a 20-year-old man of Woodbridge, a 16-year-old male juvenile of Dumfries, and two 17-year-old male juveniles, both of Woodbridge.

## Incidents

**Attempted Residential Burglary-** On March 10, officers responded to a residence located in the 14100 block of Cove Landing Dr in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate an attempted burglary. The investigation revealed on March 9 at 10:15PM, the homeowner heard a loud bang at the front door. The following morning, minor damage was discovered to the door and the deadbolt. No entry was made into the residence, and no property was reported missing. No suspect information is available.

**Vandalism on School Grounds Incidents-** On March 6, the School Resource Officer (SRO) assigned to Forest Park High School located at 15721 Forest Park Dr in Woodbridge (22193) was notified of vandalism in the library. The investigation revealed sometime between March 3 and March 6, a swastika had been drawn on a wall in the library. On March 9, a second swastika was discovered that had been drawn on a folding lunch table. No additional markings were reported, and school personnel removed the markings from both locations.

## Arrests

**Reckless Handling of a Firearm-** On March 10, officers responded to a residence located in the 16800 block of Capon Tree Lane in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a shots fired call. The investigation revealed a resident of the home, identified as the accused, discharged a firearm multiple times inside the home before leaving the area. Multiple items were damaged inside the residence. No injuries were reported and no additional property damage was reported. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Dominic **BUTLER**, was arrested.

**Assault and Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]**- On March 10 at 10:00PM, officers conducted a vehicle stop in the area of the Prince William Pkwy and Minnieville Rd in Woodbridge (22193) for a traffic violation. During the encounter, the officer cited the driver, later identified as the accused, who exited his vehicle and became confrontational with officers. As officers attempted to detain the accused, a struggle ensued. The accused assaulted an officer before being taken into custody. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Manuel Aviv **RODRIGUEZ ACEVEDO**, was arrested.
