Updates

Aggravated Malicious Wounding *ARREST- On March 17, detectives arrested the suspect sought in connection with the aggravated assault that occurred in the 13200 block of Nickelson Dr in Woodbridge (22193) on August 7, 2025. The investigation revealed the accused was an acquaintance of the victim and arrived at the victim's residence that morning. The victim opened the door to speak with the accused and a physical altercation ensued. During the struggle, the accused stabbed the victim multiple times before fleeing the area. Following the investigation, detectives obtained multiple arrest warrants for the accused, identified as Adrian Jamarr **KIDWELL**, who was arrested on March 17 near his home in Woodbridge.

Aggravated Assault [Previously Released]- On August 7 at 8:00AM, officers responded to a residence located in the 13200 block of Nickelson Dr in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate an assault. The investigation revealed a 46-year-old man had sustained multiple wounds while at the home. When officers initially arrived, no one was located at the residence, which was found unsecured. While investigating the incident, the injured man arrived at an area hospital where officers were notified. The man's injuries were determined to be non-life threatening. At this time, the events leading up to the man's injuries are still under investigation.

Attempted Sexual Battery- On March 15 at 3:00PM, officers responded to the Bull Run Swim and Raquet Club, located at 8101 Seymour Rd in Manassas (20109) to investigate a sexual assault. The investigation revealed the victim, an 18-year-old woman, was walking her dog on a walking path when she was approached by an unknown man who had been seated on a nearby bench. During the encounter, the suspect attempted to have inappropriate contact with the victim, before leaving the area on foot. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a white male, 5'4", 40-50 years in age, with missing teeth, wearing a dark-colored shirt and light-colored pants.

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On March 15 at 12:05AM, officers responded to a residence located in the 11200 block of Golden Leaf Cir in Manassas (20109) to investigate a shots fired call. The investigation revealed a gathering was taking place at the residence when an acquaintance manipulated a firearm, which discharged into the floor and damaged a neighboring residence and striking a water pipe. The suspect left the residence on foot immediately following the discharge. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a juvenile Hispanic male, with brown curly hair, wearing a gray hoodie, gray jeans, and black and white shoes.

Arrests

Assault and Battery of a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]: On February 24 at 3:00PM officers responded to a residence located in the 9100 block of Dartford PI in Bristow (20136) for a reported person in crisis. During the investigation it was determined the accused, a 12-year-old female juvenile, assaulted her father and needed to be taken to the hospital for a mental health evaluation. As officers attempted to take the accused into custody, a struggle ensued and the accused kicked and attempted to bite the officers multiple times before being detained. No injuries were reported by the officers. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as a **12-year-old female juvenile** of Bristow, was charged.
