Shooting into an Occupied Dwelling *ARREST – On March 19, detectives arrested a man sought in connection to a shots fired call that was reported to have occurred in the 13800 block of Meadowbrook Rd in Woodbridge (22193) on December 14, 2025 at approximately 4:40AM. On March 17, following the investigation, detectives obtained arrest warrants for the accused, identified as Nicholas Aaron **PARKS**, who was taken into custody on March 19 without incident.

Reckless Handling of a Firearm [Previously Reported] – On December 19, officers responded to investigate a shots fired call that was reported to have occurred in the 13800 block of Meadowbrook Rd in Woodbridge (22193) on December 14 at approximately 4:40AM. The investigation revealed a homeowner located damage to their residence which was believed to have been caused by gunfire. The homeowner reported hearing gunshots earlier in the week. A neighbor's unoccupied vehicle was also struck during the same incident. No injuries or other property damage were reported. **This incident does not appear to be random.**



Arrests

Production of Child Pornography – On March 19, Prince William County detectives as part of the DC/Northern Virginia Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force executed a search warrant at a home located in the 9400 block of Spotsylvania St in Manassas (20110) in connection to an ongoing child pornography investigation. During the execution of the search warrant, a resident of the home and target of the investigation, identified as the accused, was detained without incident. Additional evidence was also seized from the residence. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Victor Fernando **CAMPOS QUINTANILLA**, was arrested.

Threats to Bomb a School – On March 17 at 11:41AM, the School Resource Officer assigned to Independence Nontraditional School located at 14550 Aden Rd in Manassas (20112) was notified of two students who reportedly made a verbal bomb threat. Officers identified the two students and determined there was no credible threat to the students or staff. Following the investigation, both students, identified as a **15-year-old male juvenile** and a **14-year-old male juvenile**, were charged.
