**Murder Investigation \*ADDITIONAL ARREST-** The previously wanted suspect sought in connection to the 18-year-old man who was killed during a shooting that occurred in the 1800 block of Potomac Shores Pkwy in Dumfries (22026) on March 9 has been arrested. On March 23, the suspect, identified as J'Shaun Zomari **WILLIAMS**, was taken into custody by Prince William County detectives, with the assistance of the U.S. Marshal's Task Force in Richmond, VA. An adult and juvenile suspect were previously arrested in connection to this investigation. Additional details regarding this incident will be released when available. The investigation continues.

**Murder Investigation [Previously Released]** – On March 9 at 5:33PM, officers responded to an outdoor recreational area located in the 1800 block of Potomac Shores Pkwy in Dumfries (22026) to investigate a shooting. The investigation revealed several individuals were playing basketball on the courts nearby when another group arrived. During the encounter, a confrontation ensued between the arriving group and some of the individuals previously on the courts. At one point, gunfire was exchanged which caused everyone to disperse the area. Officers arrived at the scene quickly and located an individual with a gunshot wound. As the investigation progressed, another individual was located at a nearby home on Spring Cress Dr, while three other individuals had self-transported to different hospitals in the area where they were determined to be connected to the incident. In total, five males between 16-20 years of age were shot. One of the individuals, an 18-year-old man, succumbed to his injuries at the hospital. The remaining injured parties are expected to recover. Several witnesses and other possibly involved individuals were initially detained. Detectives are still sorting through who had what involvement in the encounter, and what led up to the shooting. Preliminarily, this incident does not appear to be random. Additional details will be released when available. Detectives encourage anyone who may have witnessed this incident, or have information to aid in the investigation, to contact the Prince William County Police Department. The investigation continues. **Robbery \*ADDITIONAL ARREST-** The suspect sought in connection with the robbery that occurred at BJ's Wholesale Club located at 14123 Noblewood Plz in Woodbridge (22193) on February 20 was arrested. On March 20, the suspect, identified as Rodney **JOHNSON**, was taken into custody by Fairfax County Police with the assistance of Virginia State Police. Additional charges were obtained by Fairfax County officers.

**Robbery [Previously Released]-** On February 20 at 11:33AM, officers responded to BJ's Wholesale Club located at 14123 Noblewood Plz in Woodbridge (22193) for a report of a shoplifter. The investigation revealed two unknown men, later identified as the two accused, were exiting the store with unpaid merchandise when one of the men sprayed an eye irritant into the store before leaving the area in a vehicle. Multiple people inside the business experienced symptoms and were treated at the scene by medical personnel while one person was treated at an area hospital for a non-life-threatening reaction. Following the investigation, detectives obtained arrest warrants for both men, identified as Rodney **JOHNSON** and Jhonathan Moises **UGALDE RAMOS**. On February 24, Jhonathan Moises **UGALDE RAMOS** was arrested. Attempts to locate Rodney **Johnson** were unsuccessful.

**Malicious Wounding \*ARREST-** On March 3, officers obtained charges for a suspect sought in connection to the hit and run that was reported to have occurred at 7-Eleven located at 2621 Prince William Pkwy in Woodbridge (22192) on February 15. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Demarcus **BYRDSONG**, was arrested.

**Felony Hit and Run [Previously Released]-** On February 15 at 8:55AM, officers responded to the 7-Eleven located at 2621 Prince William Pkwy in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a hit and run. The investigation revealed the victim, a 59-year-old man, was in the parking lot when he was struck by a white sedan, driven by an unknown man. After striking the victim, the suspect circled back into the parking lot. When the victim attempted to approach the suspect, the suspect struck the victim with the sedan a second time, before leaving the area in the vehicle. The victim was treated at an area hospital for non-life-threatening injuries. The suspect was described as a black male wearing dark clothing.

## Arrests

**Assault and Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]-** On March 22 at 3:01PM, officers transported a person in crisis to the UVA Health Prince William Medical Center in Manassas (20110) for a mental health evaluation. While at the hospital, the accused became aggressive toward hospital staff. An officer attempted to detain the accused and a struggle ensued. During the encounter, the accused assaulted the officer and attempted to grab the officer's firearm before being taken into custody. No injuries were reported. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Hylton **FRAY**, was charged

**Brandishing-** On March 21 at 10:10PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 7700 block of Woodstock Ct in Manassas (20109) to investigate a disorderly with weapons call. The investigation revealed that an argument occurred between the two victims, identified as a 42-year-old woman and a 42-year-old man, and an unknown man, identified as the accused, regarding the victims parking their vehicle in front of the accused's residence. During the argument, the accused brandished a firearm toward the victims and their 14-year-old son. No injuries were reported. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Tuan Kies **MATTES**, was arrested.
