### Updates

**Sexual Assault Investigations \*ADDITIONAL INCIDENTS REPORTED-** Two additional victims have come forward regarding the sexual assault that was reported to have occurred in the Powells Creek area in Woodbridge (22191) on March 10. The investigation revealed on March 10 at 4:25PM, a 41-year-old woman was walking in the area of McGuffeys Trl and Powell's Creek Blvd when she was inappropriately touched by an unknown man riding a black electric scooter. Separately, on March 26, a 53-year-old-woman reported on March 10 around 3:47PM, she was walking in the area of Powells Creek Blvd and Jedd Forest Ln when she was also inappropriately touched by an unknown man on a similar scooter. No injuries were reported in either encounter. The suspect was described as a Hispanic male, aged late teens to early 20's, 5'8", with brown wavy hair, operating a black stand-up electric scooter.

**Sexual Assault [Previously Released]-** On March 14, officers responded to investigate a sexual assault that was reported to have occurred near the intersection of River Ridge Blvd and Powells Creek Blvd in Woodbridge (22191) on March 10 at 6:50PM. The investigation revealed the victim, identified as a 26-year-old woman, was jogging in the area when she was approached by an unknown man operating a black electric scooter. During the encounter, the suspect touched the victim inappropriately before leaving the area on the scooter. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a Hispanic male, 5'8", with medium-length brown hair, wearing glasses, and a black t-shirt. While investigating the incident, it was further reported that a similar encounter involving the suspect and victim occurred in the same area in May 2025.

## Incidents

**Death investigation-** On March 26 at 6:49M, officers responded to Walmart, located at 14000 Worth Ave in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a report of an unconscious individual. The investigation revealed a 38-year-old man was found unconscious in a stall inside the men's restroom. The man was transported to an area hospital and later pronounced deceased. Preliminarily, there were no signs of foul play or threat to the community concerning the death. More information regarding the investigation will be released if deemed necessary.

**Armed Robbery-** On March 26 at 1:50PM, officers responded to Aldi located at 13782 Smoketown Rd in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a robbery. The investigation revealed an unknown man entered the store and took multiple items of merchandise. During the encounter, the accused told an employee he was armed, before leaving the area on foot. No injuries were reported and no weapon was seen. Following the investigation, officers obtained an arrest warrant for the accused, identified as Malik Lanier **DAY**. Attempts to locate Malik Lanier **DAY** were unsuccessful.

**Vandalism on School Grounds-** On March 24 at 2:00PM, the School Resource Officer (SRO) assigned to Brentsville High School located at 12109 Aden Rd in Nokesville (20181) was notified of vandalism in one of the restrooms. The investigation revealed a swastika had been etched into a partition in a men's restroom. No additional markings were reported, and school personnel removed the etching from the partition.
