

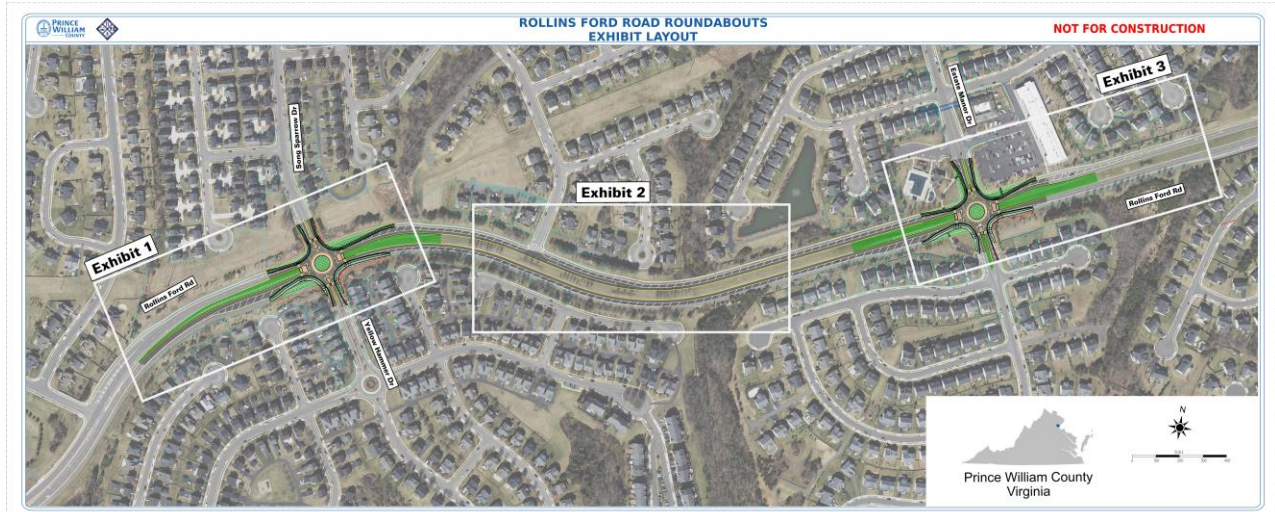
PUBLIC HEARING

ROLLINS FORD ROAD ROUNDABOUTS PROJECT

The Prince William County Department of Transportation (PWCDOT) will conduct a Public Hearing for the Rollins Ford Road Roundabouts Project at the Glenkirk Elementary School Cafeteria at 8584 Sedge Wren Dr, Gainesville, VA 20155, from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Monday, April 27, 2026. Prince William County representatives and consultant design staff will be present to discuss the project, to answer your questions, and receive suggestions on the proposed designs for roadway improvements.



The Rollins Ford Road Roundabouts Project involves the design and construction of two single-lane roundabouts at the intersections of Rollins Ford Road and Song Sparrow / Yellow Hammer Drive, and Rollins Ford Road and Estate Manor Drive. The proposed improvements would also reconfigure Rollins Ford Road between Song Sparrow / Yellow Hammer Drive and Estate Manor Drive from two lanes in each direction to one lane in each direction, with the existing outside lane removed through pavement striping.

Rollins Ford Road, Route 3500, is currently a four-lane road with a posted speed limit of 45 MPH. In 2019, VDOT completed the Rollins Ford Road Corridor Study, which investigated speed and safety concerns along the corridor. The study recommended a series of improvements including pedestrian crossing enhancements and intersection reconfigurations. The project's proposed roundabout options were selected as the preferred alternative based on stakeholder coordination and public involvement.
