File Formats

- Digital artwork only in vector format (SVG, AI, EPS), PNG, or JPEG.
- File size must be under 50MB or 8X8 inch

Resolution

- For print, 300 DPI (dots per inch) is standard.
- Minimum size: 8x8 inches at 300 DPI, which equals 2400 x 2400 pixels.

Background

- Transparent background

Other Details

- No watermarks.
- No AI work; all submissions must be original artwork (no copyrighted material).
- Include layers if using Photoshop or Illustrator (optional but helpful for adjustments).
- Safe margins: Avoid placing critical elements too close to the edges.

Artist Statement: Maximum 250 words

Deadline: April 15, 2026, at 5 PM
