

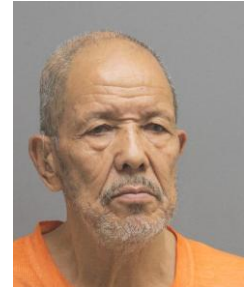

Updates

Abduction with Intent to Defile | Attempted Sexual Battery *ARREST- On April 1, detectives obtained charges for a suspect sought in connection to an attempted sexual battery that was reported to have occurred at the Bull Run Swim and Raquet Club, located at 8101 Seymour Rd in Manassas (20109) on March 15. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Mohammad **FAQIR ZADA**, was arrested.

Attempted Sexual Battery [Previously Released]- On March 15 at 3:00PM, officers responded to the Bull Run Swim and Raquet Club, located at 8101 Seymour Rd in Manassas (20109) to investigate a sexual assault. The investigation revealed the victim, an 18-year-old woman, was walking her dog on a walking path when she was approached by an unknown man who had been seated on a nearby bench. During the encounter, the suspect attempted to have inappropriate contact with the victim, before leaving the area on foot. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a white male, 5'4", 40-50 years in age, with missing teeth, wearing a dark-colored shirt and light-colored pants.

Bank Robbery- On April 1, officers responded to Capital One Bank, located at 13236 Gateway Center Dr in Gainesville (20155) to investigate a robbery. The investigation revealed an unknown man entered the bank, jumped over the counter, and demanded money from the tellers. The suspect took an undisclosed amount of money before leaving the area in a white sedan. No injuries were reported and no weapon was displayed. The suspect was described as a white male, 5'10" wearing a grey zippered jacket, blue jeans, hiking boots, sunglasses, black gloves and a black surgical mask.
