Attempted Malicious Wounding | Shooting at an Occupied Vehicle *ARREST- On April 2, a suspect identified as Terry Angelo **CLAYTON** Jr, who was determined to be involved in the shots fired call that was reported to have occurred in the area of Rylstone Ln and Sweeney Ln in Woodbridge (22191) on March 6, was arrested. The accused was taken into custody by Prince William County detectives at his home in Dumfries.



Arrested on April 2:

Charged with three counts of **attempted malicious wounding**, 3 counts of **use of a firearm in commission of a felony** and one count of **shooting at an occupied vehicle**

Reckless Handling of a Firearm Incidents [Previously Released]- On March 6 at 1:37PM, officers responded to the area of Rylstone Ln and Sweeney Ln in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a shots fired call. The investigation revealed the victims, a 38-year-old man and two juveniles, were inside their vehicle when a black SUV approached. During the encounter, an unknown man exited the SUV and fired multiple gunshots towards the victim's vehicle before leaving the area. One shell casing was located in the roadway. The suspect was described as a black male, in his late 20's or early 30's. This incident is believed to be related to two additional property damage calls that were reported on March 7. The investigation into those incidents revealed two separate nearby homes, one in the 16800 block of Sweeney Ln and the other in the 2500 block of Miranda Ct, were struck by gunfire possibly related to the previous reported incident on March 6. No injuries were reported in any of the incidents.

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On April 2 at 11:56PM, officers responded to a residence in the 1400 block of Harrison St in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a shooting. The investigation revealed that the suspect, identified as a 30-year-old man, was handling a firearm when it accidentally discharged. The bullet struck the suspect, resulting in non-life-threatening injuries. The suspect was transported to an area hospital for treatment and no additional injuries or damage to property were reported. Charges are pending.

Arrests

Assault and Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]- On April 2 at 7:20PM, officers responded to Walmart located at 8386 Sudley Rd in Manassas (20109) to investigate shoplifting. The investigation revealed three juvenile females took merchandise and exited the store. Officers stopped the juveniles at which point a struggle ensued between one of the juvenile females, identified as the accused, and the officers. During the encounter, the accused assaulted an officer before being placed into custody. While being escorted to a police cruiser the accused assaulted a second officer. Minor injuries were reported by one of the officers. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as a **16-year-old female juvenile**, was arrested.

Indecent Exposure- On April 2 at 5:00AM, officers responded to the Wawa, located at 10691 Davidson Pl in Manassas (20109) to investigate an indecent exposure. The investigation revealed an unknown man, later identified as the accused, exposed himself and took merchandise from the store, before leaving the area on foot. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Karris Dequan **FRAZIER**, was arrested.
