

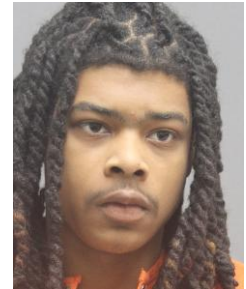

Updates

Murder Investigation *ADDITIONAL ARREST- Detectives have obtained additional charges in connection to the ongoing investigation into the 18-year-old man who was killed during a shooting that occurred in the 1800 block of Potomac Shores Pkwy in Dumfries (22026) on March 9. On April 8, Prince William County detectives, with the assistance of the U.S. Marshal's Task Force, arrested the accused, identified as Kennsington Duane **ADAMS**, at his home in Dumfries. Additional details regarding this incident will be released when available. The investigation continues.

**Continuation of the investigative update from the previous page*

Murder Investigation [Previously Released] – On March 9 at 5:33PM, officers responded to an outdoor recreational area located in the 1800 block of Potomac Shores Pkwy in Dumfries (22026) to investigate a shooting. The investigation revealed several individuals were playing basketball on the courts nearby when another group arrived. During the encounter, a confrontation ensued between the arriving group and some of the individuals previously on the courts. At one point, gunfire was exchanged which caused everyone to disperse the area. Officers arrived at the scene quickly and located an individual with a gunshot wound. As the investigation progressed, another individual was located at a nearby home on Spring Cress Dr, while three other individuals had self-transported to different hospitals in the area where they were determined to be connected to the incident. In total, five males between 16-20 years of age were shot. One of the individuals, an 18-year-old man, succumbed to his injuries at the hospital. The remaining injured parties are expected to recover. Several witnesses and other possibly involved individuals were initially detained. Detectives are still sorting through who had what involvement in the encounter, and what led up to the shooting. Preliminarily, this incident does not appear to be random. Additional details will be released when available. Detectives encourage anyone who may have witnessed this incident, or have information to aid in the investigation, to contact the Prince William County Police Department. The investigation continues. Arrests

Assault & Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]- On April 7 at 10:43AM, officers were in the 7400 block of Miramar Dr in Manassas (20109) when they located a stolen vehicle. The driver of the vehicle, identified as the accused, was arrested and transported to an area hospital to receive treatment for minor injuries. While in custody, the accused became agitated and fled from the officers. A struggle ensued during which the accused assaulted an officer before being placed into custody. No injuries were reported by the officer. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Andre Jon **RICHARDSON**, was arrested.
