Incidents

Aggravated Assault- On April 7 at 11:50PM officers responded to the 13600 block of Cridercrest Pl in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a road rage incident. The investigation revealed the victim, a 19-year-old man, was involved in a verbal altercation with the driver of another vehicle. During the encounter, the suspect exited his vehicle and sprayed a chemical irritant on the victim before leaving the area. The victim complained of pain from exposure to the chemical irritant. The suspect was described as a white male, 6'0", 190lbs, dressed in black clothing and driving a grey Nissan Sentra.

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On April 9, officers responded to a residence located in the 14700 block of Darbydale Ave in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a shots fired call. The investigation revealed on April 8 at 1:00AM, multiple gunshots were heard in the area. Several shell casings were located near the driveway of the residence. No injuries or property damage were reported. No suspect information could be provided.

Arrests

Brandishing- On April 9 at 1:23PM, officers responded to the 12000 block of Darby Brooke Ct in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a road rage incident. The investigation revealed the victim, a 38-year-old man, was involved in a verbal altercation with the driver of another vehicle, later identified as the accused. During the encounter, the accused brandished a firearm at the victim before the parties separated. No shots were fired and no injuries were reported. Following the investigation the accused, identified as Yesser **BELLAGHA**, was charged and released on a court summons.
