Incidents

Fatal Crash Investigation- On April 10 at 2:29PM, officers responded to the 12700 block Harbor Dr and Old Bridge Rd in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a crash. The investigation revealed the driver of a 2014 Hyundai Sonata entered Harbor Dr from a private road and was struck by a 2018 Dodge Durango traveling southbound on Harbor Dr. The driver of the Hyundai, identified as a 41-year-old man, was pronounced deceased. The other driver, a 25-year-old man, sustained non-life-threatening injuries. **Crash investigators are asking anyone who may have witnessed this crash to contact police.**

Brandishing- On April 10 at 2:40PM, officers responded to the area of Dumfries Rd and Richmond Hwy in Dumfries (22026) to investigate a road rage incident. The investigation revealed the victim, a 55-year-old man, was involved in a verbal altercation with the passenger of another vehicle. During the encounter, the suspect threw a water bottle at the victim's vehicle and brandished a firearm at the victim, before leaving the area. No shots were fired and no injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a white male approximately 30 years old, with blonde hair, wearing a brown jacket and riding in a red Toyota sedan.

Residential Burglary- On April 12, officers responded to a residence located in the 18500 block of Tralee Ln in Triangle (22172) to investigate a burglary. The investigation revealed between April 11 at 11:30AM and April 12 at 9:20PM the residence was entered, possibly through the back door that was found damaged and multiple rooms were rummaged through. A television and iPad were reported to be damaged and multiple items, including jewelry, were reported missing. No suspect information was available.

Arrests

Assault and Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer (LEO)- On April 10 at 7:26PM, officers responded to the Hilton Garden Inn located at 15001 Haymarket St in Haymarket (20169) for a report of an individual making harassing phone calls to the Public Safety Communications Center. Officers located the individual, identified as the accused, in an intoxicated state. Officers took the accused into custody and while being escorted to a police cruiser, the accused became agitated and kicked a Haymarket police officer. No injuries were reported by the officer. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as David Anthony **MURPHY**, was arrested.

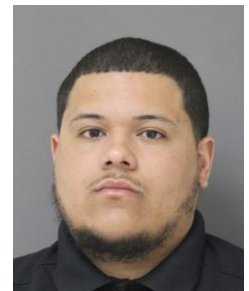

Brandishing- On April 10 at 6:10PM, officers responded to the area of Centreville Rd and Maplewood Dr in Manassas (20111) to investigate a road rage incident. The investigation revealed the victim, a 44-year-old man, was involved in a verbal altercation with the driver of another vehicle, later identified as the accused. During the encounter, the accused brandished a firearm at the victim before the parties separated. No shots were fired and no injuries were reported. Following the investigation the accused, identified as Richard Ronniel **VALOIS**, was arrested.
