### Updates

**Sexual Assault Investigations \*ADDITIONAL INCIDENT REPORTED-** An additional victim has come forward regarding multiple sexual assaults that are reported to have occurred in the Powells Creek area in Woodbridge (22191) on March 10. The investigation into the latest incident revealed on April 17 at 3:36PM, the victim, a 45-year-old woman, was walking on Blue Pool Dr near Paper Mill Ln in Woodbridge (22191) when she was inappropriately touched by an unknown man operating a black, stand-up electric scooter. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as wearing a black graphic tee and grey shorts.

**Sexual Assault Investigations [Previously Released]-**Two additional victims have come forward regarding the sexual assault that was reported to have occurred in the Powells Creek area in Woodbridge (22191) on March 10. The investigation revealed on March 10 at 4:25PM, a 41-year-old woman was walking in the area of McGuffeys Trl and Powell's Creek Blvd when she was inappropriately touched by an unknown man riding a black electric scooter. Separately, on March 26, a 53-year-old-woman reported on March 10 around 3:47PM, she was walking in the area of Powells Creek Blvd and Jedd Forest Ln when she was also inappropriately touched by an unknown man on a similar scooter. No injuries were reported in either encounter. The suspect was described as a Hispanic male, aged late teens to early 20's, 5'8", with brown wavy hair, operating a black stand-up electric scooter.

**Sexual Assault [Previously Released]-** On March 14, officers responded to investigate a sexual assault that was reported to have occurred near the intersection of River Ridge Blvd and Powells Creek Blvd in Woodbridge (22191) on March 10 at 6:50PM. The investigation revealed the victim, identified as a 26-year-old woman, was jogging in the area when she was approached by an unknown man operating a black electric scooter. During the encounter, the suspect touched the victim inappropriately before leaving the area on the scooter. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a Hispanic male, 5'8", with medium-length brown hair, wearing glasses, and a black t-shirt. While investigating the incident, it was further reported that a similar encounter involving the suspect and victim occurred in the same area in May 2025.

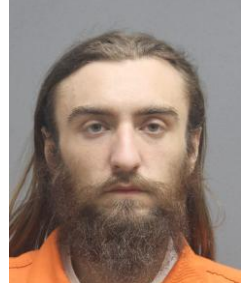
## Incidents

**Brandishing-** On April 17 at 5:30PM, officers responded to the intersection of Minnieville Rd and Harvest Moon Ln in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a road rage incident. The investigation revealed the victim, a 22-year-old man, was followed by an unknown man driving a black Toyota Camry. During the encounter, the suspect brandished a firearm at the victim. No shots were fired and no injuries were reported. The suspect was described a white male, mid 20's, shirtless, with tattoos and wearing a black hat.

**Residential Burglary-** On April 19, officers responded to a residence located in the 14200 block of Bremerton Dr in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate burglary. The investigation revealed at 11:27AM that day, an unknown man entered the residence through a window, rummaged through multiple rooms and took a guitar and various tools before leaving the area on foot. The suspect was described as a male wearing a jumpsuit with a hood up.

## Arrests

**Attempted Bank Robbery-** On April 18 at 4:56PM, officers responded to the Woodforest National Bank located inside Walmart at 8386 Sudley Rd in Manassas (20109) for a report of an attempted robbery. The investigation revealed an unknown man wearing a ski mask, later identified as the accused, approached the bank teller and advised her that he wanted to rob the bank. The accused then picked up a donation box from one of the counters and set it back down before leaving the area. Officers quickly located the accused who was taken into custody. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Ryan William **COCKRILL**, was arrested.
