

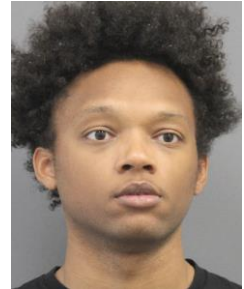

Updates

Sexual Assault *ARREST- On April 20, the suspect, identified as Kendall Jamal **MILLER**, who was sought in connection to a sexual assault that was reported to have occurred at Gabe's located at 14567 Richmond Hwy in Woodbridge (22191) on April 3, was arrested.



Arrested on April 20:

Kendall Jamal **MILLER**, 24, of Dumfries

Described as a black male, 6'1, 152lbs, with brown eyes and black hair

Wanted for **sexual battery**

Sexual Assault *WANTED SUSPECT [Previously Released] - Prince William County Police are currently seeking the suspect involved in a sexual assault that was reported to have occurred at Gabe's located at 14567 Richmond Hwy in Woodbridge (22191) on April 3. During the investigation, officers identified the suspect as Kendall Jamal **MILLER** and obtained an arrest warrant. Attempts to locate the suspect have been unsuccessful.

Sexual Assault [Previously Released] - On April 3 at 5:53PM, officers responded to Gabe's located at 14567 Richmond Hwy in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate an assault. The investigation revealed the victim, a 39-year-old woman, was shopping inside the store when she was approached by an unknown man who touched her inappropriately. No additional contact was made between the two parties before the man left the store. No injuries were reported.

Incidents

Strong-Arm Robbery - On April 20, officers responded to investigate a robbery that was reported to have occurred at the ABC store located at 11010 Sudley Manor Dr in Manassas (20109) earlier that afternoon at approximately 12:240PM. The investigation revealed an unknown man threatened an employee before leaving the business with unpaid merchandise. No injuries were reported. Suspect was described as a male, late teens to early 20s, approximately 5'7", 140lbs wearing dark colored clothing.

Reckless Handling of a Firearm – On April 21 at 1:32AM, officers responded to a residence located in the 7500 block of Bosbury Ct in Manassas (20111) to investigate a shots fired call. The investigation revealed the home and the homeowner's unoccupied vehicle had been struck by gunfire. No injuries or other property damage were reported. A police K-9 searched the area for possible involved parties who were not located. Shell casings were located on the property.

Reckless Handling of a Firearm – On April 21 at 1:44AM, officers responded to the 8100 block of Claremont St in Manassas (20109) to investigate a shots fired call. The investigation revealed two unoccupied vehicles had been struck by gunfire. No injuries or other property damage were reported. Shell casings were located in the roadway.

Arrests

Assault & Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO] – On April 20 7:07PM, officers responded to the 15900 block of Donald Curtis Dr in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate an intoxicated individual. Officers arrived and detained the accused for public intoxication. Once transported to a nearby police station, the accused became combative and lunged at an officer, striking the officer to the chest. The accused was eventually detained. The officer was not injured. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Kavawn Quintell **HARMON**, was arrested.
