Incidents

Strong-Armed Robbery- On April 29 at 10:38PM, officers responded to the 7-Eleven located at 2631 Prince William Pkwy in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a robbery. The investigation revealed an unknown man entered the store and took a phone charger. While exiting the store, the suspect assaulted an employee before leaving the area in a red sedan. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a black male, clean shaven with long dreadlocks, wearing a black hoodie and black pants.

Arrests

Indecent Exposure- On April 29 at 8:26PM, officers responded to the Woodbridge Laundromat, located at 1300 F St in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate indecent exposure. The investigation revealed an unknown man, later identified as the accused, was found to be intoxicated and attempted to enter the business. When the accused was unable to gain entry, he exposed himself to the victim, a 40-year-old woman. During the investigation, it was determined the accused also exposed himself to the victim, and an additional victim, a 61-year-old woman, earlier in the evening. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as David Alredo **OCHOA**, was arrested.
