Incidents

Shooting Investigation – On May 3 at 6:23PM, officers responded to 2900 block of Hickory Creek Ct in Dumfries (22026) to investigate a shooting. The investigation revealed a 20-year-old man had been shot to the lower body. The man was transported to an area hospital for treatment of the non-life threatening injury. A police K-9 searched the area for a crime scene and other parties possibly involved in the incident, neither of which were located. The victim was not cooperative with investigators as to what led to the encounter. No suspect description was provided.

Arrests

Reckless Handling of a Firearm – On May 2 at 8:09PM, officers responded to the 5000 block of Anchorstone Dr in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a destruction of property. The investigation revealed the accused was cleaning a firearm when it discharged and entered a neighboring residence. The projectile eventually struck a water pipe causing damage to other residences. No injuries were reported. Officers further determined the firearm was a “ghost gun” with no identifiable serial number. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Elijah D’Mitri **MILLER**, was charged.

Assault & Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO] – On May 2 at 7:36PM, officers responded to Joplin Rd between mile markers 19 & 20 in Triangle (22172) to investigate an individual walking in the roadway. When officers arrived, they made contact with an individual, later identified as the accused, who was subsequently detained for being intoxicated. While in custody, the accused attempted inappropriate contact with an officer. No injuries were reported by the officer. Assault & Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO] – On May 1 at 5:45PM, officers were conducting routine patrol in the area of Potomac Mills located in the 2900 block of Potomac Mills Rd in Woodbridge (22192) when they encountered the accused.
