Incidents

Sexual Assault- On May 10 at 6:20PM, officers responded to the Dollar Tree located at 1911 Daniel Stuart Sq in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a sexual assault. The investigation revealed the victim, a 62-year-old woman, was in the store when she was approached by an unknown man. During the encounter, the suspect touched the victim inappropriately, before leaving the area on foot. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a white male, tall, aged 20-30 years, with long, burgundy-colored hair, wearing a dark gray hoodie, gray pants, white shoes, pink backpack and carrying a skateboard.

Sexual Assault- On May 9 at 1:26PM, officers responded to the area of Featherstone Rd and Featherstone Gate Dr in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a sexual assault. The investigation revealed the victim, a 32-year-old woman, was walking on Featherstone Rd when she was approached by an unknown man. During the encounter the suspect inappropriately touched the victim, before leaving the area on foot. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a Hispanic male, aged 15-25 years, with medium length brown hair, wearing a black hoodie and grey jeans.

Strong-Armed Robbery- On May 8, officers responded to Nordstrom Rack located at 2700 Potomac Mills Cir in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a robbery that reportedly took place at approximately 2:53PM. The investigation revealed an unknown man entered the store and took merchandise. During the encounter, the suspect assaulted an employee, before leaving the area on foot. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a white male, aged 25-35 years, wearing an orange beanie, blue hoodie, gray shorts, and black and white sneakers.

Residential Burglary- On May 9, officers responded to a residence located in the 7400 block of Barbados Ln in Manassas (20109) to investigate burglary that was reported to have occurred on May 8 at 10:13PM. The investigation revealed an unknown man entered the garage and took a black bag containing a rifle, magazines and ammunition. No damage to property was reported. The suspect was described as a male wearing a blue hoodie, white shirt and black pants.

The investigation revealed the victims, two adults and a 15-year-old juvenile male, were involved in a verbal argument with an unknown man, later identified as the accused, regarding a parking spot. During the encounter, the accused brandished a firearm at the victims. No injuries were reported and no shots were fired. 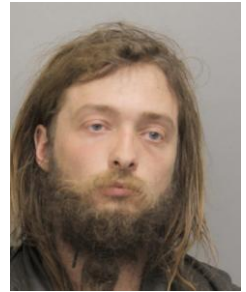

Strong-Armed Robbery | Indecent Exposure- On May 8 at 10:50AM, officers responded to the Panda Express, located at 2990 Prince William Pkwy in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a robbery. The investigation revealed the victim, a 38-year-old man, was approached by an unknown man, later identified as the accused, and assaulted. During the encounter, the accused took one of the victim's shoes and exposed himself to the victim, before leaving the area on foot. Following the investigation, officers obtained charges and the accused, identified as Kevin Richard **WELDON**, was arrested.

Assault and Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]- On May 10 at 8:25PM, officers responded to a residence located at 12717 Lockleven Ln in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a domestic disturbance. The investigation revealed one of the parties, later identified as the accused, was intoxicated and refused to leave an acquaintance's residence. Officers arrested the accused for trespassing and transported her to an area hospital for medical treatment. While at the hospital, the accused became aggressive and assaulted an officer before being secured. Minor injuries were reported by the officer. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Megan Leigh **PROCHASKA**, was arrested.

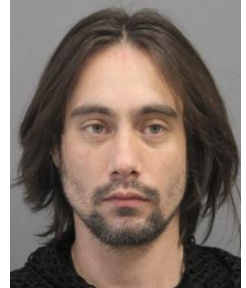

Assault and Battery of a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]- On May 10 at 1:45AM, officers responded to a residence located in the 3800 block of Del Mar Dr in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a domestic disturbance. The investigation revealed one of the parties involved, later identified as the accused, was intoxicated and assaulted multiple individuals at the residence. Upon arrival at the home, officers observed the accused actively assaulting another party in the front yard. Officers attempted to detain the accused, at which point a struggle ensued. During the encounter, the accused assaulted an officer, before being quickly taken into custody. No injuries were reported by the officer. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Christopher Robin **BELCHER**, was arrested.
