Residential Burglary *ARREST- On May 11, officers arrested a juvenile suspect in connection to the burglary that was reported to have occurred on in the 7400 block of Barbados Ln in Manassas on May 8 at 10:23PM. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as a **14-year-old male juvenile**, was taken into custody without incident.

Residential Burglary [Previously Released]- On May 9, officers responded to a residence located in the 7400 block of Barbados Ln in Manassas (20109) to investigate burglary that was reported to have occurred on May 8 at 10:13PM. The investigation revealed an unknown man entered the garage and took a black bag containing a rifle, magazines and ammunition. No damage to property was reported. The suspect was described as a male wearing a blue hoodie, white shirt and black pants.

Incidents

Assault with a Caustic Substance- On May 11, officers responded investigate an assault that was reported to have occurred in the 13400 block of Richmond Hwy in Woodbridge (22191) earlier that afternoon at 1:19PM. The investigation revealed the victim, a 40-year-old man, was sitting in his parked vehicle when he was approached by an unknown man driving a Jeep Wrangler. A verbal altercation ensued and during the encounter, the suspect exited the vehicle and sprayed a chemical irritant on the victim before leaving the area. The victim complained of pain from exposure to the chemical irritant. The suspect was described as a white male, 5'6" with blonde hair, aged 30-40 years, wearing a light green shirt, shorts and tennis shoes.

Vandalism on School Grounds- On May 8 at 1:29PM, the School Resource Officer (SRO) assigned to Herbert J. Saunders Middle School located at 13557 Spriggs Rd in Manassas (20112) was notified of vandalism in one of the restrooms. The investigation revealed derogatory lettering had been written in marker on a door in the girl's restroom. Additional lettering was also located on a locker in the hallway. School personnel removed the lettering from the door and the locker.

Arrests

Sexual Assault Investigations- On May 8, detectives concluded an investigation into a series of sexual assaults that were reported to have occurred at Mainsprings Recovery Center located at 17470 Fraley Blvd between December 29, 2025 and January 12, 2026. The investigation revealed during that timeframe, four adult women were inappropriately touched by a male staff member, identified as the accused. No injuries were reported. Following the investigation, detectives obtained charges for the accused and on May 8, detectives with the assistance of the U.S. Marshals Task Force and the Stafford County Sheriff's Office took the accused, identified as Mr. Jasbert Curtis **FITCHETT** Jr. into custody.

Armed Robbery- On May 11 at 7:05pm, officers responded to the 8400 block of Irongate Way in Manassas (20109) to investigate a robbery. The investigation revealed the victims, two 15-year-old juvenile males, had arranged to sell clothing via Instagram. The victims met two other juvenile males to complete the transaction when during the encounter, one of the suspects, identified as the accused, grabbed the clothing from the victims. A struggle ensued and the second suspect brandished a firearm at the victims and demanded the clothing, before leaving the area on foot. No injuries were reported. Following the investigation, officers obtained charges for the accused, identified as a **16-year-old male juvenile**. The investigation into the identity of the second suspect is ongoing.
