

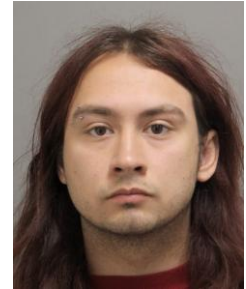


DAILY INCIDENT REPORT

Updates

Sexual Assault Investigations *ARREST- On May 14, officers arrested a suspect in connection to the sexual assault that was reported to have occurred at the Dollar Tree located at 1911 Daniel Stuart Sq in Woodbridge (22191) on May 10 at 6:20PM. During the investigation an additional victim came forward and reported being inappropriately touched by an unknown male, identified as the accused, while shopping at the Savers Thrift Store located at 14427 Potomac Mills Rd in Woodbridge (22192) on May 8 at 10:00AM. No injuries were reported. Following the investigation, officers obtained charges and the accused, identified as Curtis Anthony **Moore**, was arrested.

Sexual Assault [Previously Reported]- On May 10 at 6:20PM, officers responded to the Dollar Tree located at 1911 Daniel Stuart Sq in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a sexual assault. The investigation revealed the victim, a 62-year-old woman, was in the store when she was approached by an unknown man. During the encounter, the suspect touched the victim inappropriately, before leaving the area on foot. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a white male, tall, aged 20-30 years, with long, burgundy-colored hair, wearing a dark gray hoodie, gray pants, white shoes, pink backpack and carrying a skateboard.

Sexual Assault Investigation- On April 3, officers responded to investigate a sexual assault that reportedly occurred at Optimal Sleep and Weight Loss Clinic, located at 13000 Harbor Center Dr in Woodbridge (22192) on April 1 at 12:28PM. The investigation revealed the victim, a 42-year-old woman, was receiving treatment at the clinic when she was inappropriately touched by her doctor, identified as the accused. On May 13, officers obtained an arrest warrant for the accused, identified as Pascal Bobga **Ngongmon**. Attempts to locate Pascal Bobga **Ngongmon** were unsuccessful.

Wanted for *aggravated sexual battery*

Malicious Wounding- On May 12 at 1:07PM, officers responded to the 2700 block of Neabsco Common Pl in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate an assault. The investigation revealed the victim, an employee of the apartment complex, saw three unknown men smoking marijuana in a common area and advised them to leave the premise. During the encounter, the suspects assaulted the victim, before leaving the area in a vehicle. The victim sustained injuries and was transported to an area hospital for treatment.

Suspect descriptions:

Black male, aged 20-22 years, wearing a black hoodie, black sweatpants and a red and yellow headband

Black male, aged 20, wearing a dark colored beanie, grey North Face hoodie, black pants, white and black shoes and carrying a black crossbody bag

Black male, aged 16-18 years, medium length hair, wearing a black hoodie, black pants and black and white shoes

Armed Robbery- On May 14, officers responded to investigate a robbery that was reported to have occurred on a walking path behind the 17100 block of Richmond Hwy in Dumfries (22026) at approximately 12:33AM. The investigation revealed the victim, a 33-year-old man, was walking on the path when he encountered an unknown man. The suspect displayed a knife and demanded the victim's money. The victim gave the suspect an undisclosed amount of money and the suspect left the area on foot. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a black male, mid 40's, wearing dark clothing.

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On May 11 at 1:00AM officers responded to Round 1 located at 2700 Potomac Mills Cir in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a report of shots fired. The investigation revealed an argument occurred involving a large group of individuals outside the doors of the business. During the encounter, an unknown man in the rear passenger seat of a sedan, produced a firearm and fired gunshots in the direction of another vehicle in the area. Both vehicles left the area, and officers were unable to locate any potential victims. No injuries or damage to property were reported. The suspect was described as a light complexioned, black male.

Arrests

Assault and Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]- On May 13 at 8:33PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 2900 block of Fox Lair Dr in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate an assault. The investigation revealed a woman, later identified as the accused was intoxicated and assaulted an acquaintance. Officers took the accused into custody and while being seated in the police cruiser, the accused became aggressive and kicked an officer twice. No injuries were reported by the officer. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Ashley Lyn **APONTE**, was arrested.

Indecent Exposure- On May 9 at 11:05AM, officers responded to the 13800 block of Foulger Sq in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate an individual with a weapon. The investigation revealed the individual, later identified as the accused, was holding a box cutter and threatening patrons. While speaking with the officers, the accused dropped the box cutter and became aggressive towards the officers, who quickly took him into custody. While at the Prince William - Manassas Regional Adult Detention Center, the accused exposed himself and made explicit gestures. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Marufe **MILLYARD**, was arrested.
