Incidents

Death Investigation – On May 10 at 5:02PM, an officer was flagged down in the area of the Days Inn located at 7249 New Market Ct in Manassas (20109) regarding an individual who was reportedly naked in a side lobby. The officer attempted to provide assistance to the individual, later identified as a 53-year-old man, who suddenly became aggressive and displayed signs of being under the influence of narcotics. The man was subsequently detained without incident while the officer requested additional police assistance and medical services. While in police custody, the man was placed in a seated position and became unresponsive. Medical services transported the man to an area hospital where he remained in critical condition and later died on May 15. No force was used on the man by officers while he was in police custody. Currently, the death is believed to be medical related, possibly due to ingested narcotics. The deceased was transported to the Medical Examiner’s Office for an autopsy to determine the official cause and manner of death. More information regarding the investigation will be released if deemed necessary. The investigation continues.

Death Investigation- On May 16 at 9:10PM, officers responded to the 18000 block of Joplin Road in Triangle (22172) to investigate a vehicle that reportedly struck a tree. The driver of the vehicle, a 22-year-old man, was located by officers with a self-inflicted gunshot wound. The man was pronounced dead on scene. Preliminarily, there were no signs of foul play or threat to the community concerning the death. More information regarding the investigation will be released if deemed necessary

Aggravated Assault- On May 17 at 1:39AM, officers responded to El Ranchon, located at 13638 Richmond Hwy in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a stabbing. The investigation revealed the victim, a 25- year-old man, and a family member were involved in a physical altercation with an unknown man and woman. During the encounter, one of the parties stabbed the victim in the leg, before leaving the area. The victim sustained serious injuries and was transported to an area hospital for treatment.

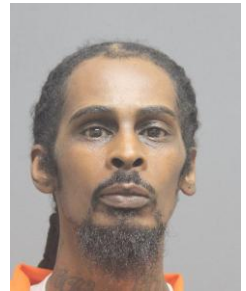

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On May 15 at 11:55AM, officers responded to the intersection of Catharpin Rd and Heathcote Blvd in Gainesville (20155) to investigate a road rage incident. The investigation revealed the driver of a blue sedan overtook a white SUV while traveling on Heathcote Blvd. The driver of the white SUV then brandished a firearm and fired one gunshot in the direction of the blue sedan. Both vehicles then left the area in the direction of James Madison Hwy. One shell casing was located in the roadway. No injuries or damage to property were reported. The suspect was described as a black male, with a muscular build.

Arrests

Homicide Investigation- On May 17 at 12:10AM, officers responded to the Shell service station located at 17250 Dumfries Rd in Dumfries (22026) to investigate a stabbing. Officers quickly arrived on scene and located a man with a stab wound near the gas pumps. The investigation revealed the victim, a 20-year-old man, became involved in a physical altercation with an employee of the business. During the altercation, the employee, identified as the accused, produced a knife, and stabbed the victim once in the upper body. Following the encounter, the victim collapsed and became unresponsive. Arriving medics provided aid to the victim, and he was ultimately pronounced dead on scene. The accused was quickly taken into custody by officers without incident. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Michael Orlando **DICKEY**, was arrested. **Detectives are asking anyone with any information, or anyone who may have witnessed the incident, to contact police.** Additional information will be released when available. The investigation continues.
