**Sexual Assault Investigation \*ARREST-** The suspect sought in connection with the sexual assault that was reported to have occurred at the Optimal Sleep and Weight Loss Clinic, located at 13000 Harbor Center Dr in Woodbridge (22192) on April 1, was arrested. On May 19, the suspect, identified as Pascal Bobga **NGONGMON**, was taken into custody by Stafford County Sheriff's Office.

**Sexual Assault Investigation [Previously Released]-** On April 3, officers responded to investigate a sexual assault that reportedly occurred at Optimal Sleep and Weight Loss Clinic, located at 13000 Harbor Center Dr in Woodbridge (22192) on April 1 at 12:28PM. The investigation revealed the victim, a 42-year-old woman, was receiving treatment at the clinic when she was inappropriately touched by her doctor, identified as the accused. On May 13, officers obtained an arrest warrant for the accused, identified as Pascal Bobga **NGONGMON**. Attempts to locate Pascal Bobga **NGONGMON** were unsuccessful.

**Sexual Assault Investigations \*CHARGES OBTAINED-** On May 19, detectives charged a juvenile suspect in connection with the series of sexual assaults that were reported to have occurred in the Powell's Creek area in Woodbridge (22191) in May 2025 and the again in between March and April 2026. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as a **17-year-old male juvenile**, was charged.

**Sexual Assault Investigations [Previously Released]-** An additional victim has come forward regarding multiple sexual assaults that are reported to have occurred in the Powells Creek area in Woodbridge (22191) on March 10. The investigation into the latest incident revealed on April 17 at 3:36PM, the victim, a 45-year-old woman, was walking on Blue Pool Dr near Paper Mill Ln in Woodbridge (22191) when she was inappropriately touched by an unknown man operating a black, stand-up electric scooter. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as wearing a black graphic tee and grey shorts.

**Sexual Assault Investigations [Previously Released]-** Two additional victims have come forward regarding the sexual assault that was reported to have occurred in the Powells Creek area in Woodbridge (22191) on March 10. The investigation revealed on March 10 at 4:25PM, a 41-year-old woman was walking in the area of McGuffeys Trl and Powell's Creek Blvd when she was inappropriately touched by an unknown man riding a black electric scooter. Separately, on March 26, a 53-year-old-woman reported on March 10 around 3:47PM, she was walking in the area of Powells Creek Blvd and Jedd Forest Ln when she was also inappropriately touched by an unknown man on a similar scooter. No injuries were reported in either encounter. The suspect was described as a Hispanic male, aged late teens to early 20's, 5'8", with brown wavy hair, operating a black stand-up electric scooter.

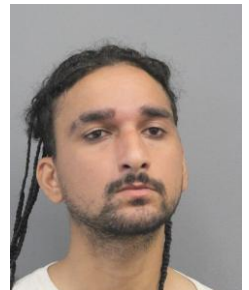

**Sexual Assault [Previously Released]**- On March 14, officers responded to investigate a sexual assault that was reported to have occurred near the intersection of River Ridge Blvd and Powells Creek Blvd in Woodbridge (22191) on March 10 at 6:50PM. The investigation revealed the victim, identified as a 26-year-old woman, was jogging in the area when she was approached by an unknown man operating a black electric scooter. During the encounter, the suspect touched the victim inappropriately before leaving the area on the scooter. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a Hispanic male, 5'8", with medium-length brown hair, wearing glasses, and a black t-shirt. While investigating the incident, it was further reported that a similar encounter involving the suspect and victim occurred in the same area in May 2025.

## Arrests

**Felony Assault [Hate Crime]**- On May 19 at 2:00PM, officers responded to the Neabsco Potomac Commuter Garage located at 2450 Neabsco Stream Dr in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate an assault. The investigation revealed the victim, a 35-year-old woman, was at the bus stop when she was approached by an unknown man, later identified as the accused. The accused questioned the victim about her religion and global events. During the encounter, the accused became agitated and assaulted her before taking an item of her clothing and leaving the area on a bus. The victim sustained minor injuries. The accused was quickly located by officers and detained. Following the investigation, the suspect, identified as Zohaib Jamil **AHMAD**, was arrested
