

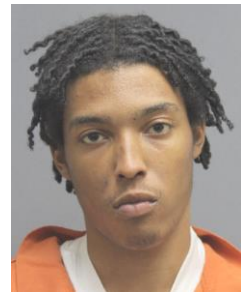

Updates

Murder Investigation *ARRESTS – Prince William County detectives have charged two men in connection to the shooting death of a 42-year-old Bowling Green man which stemmed from an altercation that occurred in the 1200 block of Potomac Vista Dr in Woodbridge (22191) on May 12. The suspects were known to the victim, and the incident stemmed from a narcotics transaction. Following the investigation, both men, identified as Taiyon Damari **JACKSON** and William Latrale **LISENBY**, were arrested.



JACKSON

**Continuation of the investigative update from the previous page.*

Homicide Investigation [Previously Released] – On May 12 at 8:58PM, officers responded to the 1200 block of Potomac Vista Dr in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a shooting. Officers quickly arrived on scene and were made aware a man had sustained gunshot wounds and was transported to an area hospital prior to police arrival. The investigation revealed the victim, a 42-year-old man, was in the parking lot when he became involved in a physical altercation with another man. During the encounter, a third man became involved, produced a firearm, and shot the victim multiple times. The victim was able to get to his vehicle and was transported to an area hospital by a family member, where he later died. The suspects left the area and were not immediately located. **Preliminarily, this incident does not appear random. Detectives are asking anyone with any information, or anyone who may have witnessed the incident, to contact police.** Additional information will be released when available. The investigation continues.

Residential Burglary – On May 24 at 5:30AM, officers responded to the Kincaid at Caton Hill apartments located in the 2600 block of Nettilling Way in Woodridge (22192) to investigate a burglary. The investigation revealed a resident of an apartment woke to the sound of a bedroom window being shattered and observed an unknown figure who immediately ran off in an unknown direction. Officers checked the area for a possible suspect who was not located. No property was reported missing.

Residential Burglary – On May 23 at 9:01PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 1500 block of Woodside Dr in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a burglary. The investigation revealed the home was entered sometime between 10:30AM and 1:30PM through a rear door which was found damaged. An undisclosed amount of money was reported missing.

Arrests

Attempted Malicious Wounding | Abduction | Brandishing a Knife – On May 22 at 4:01AM, officers responded to a residence located in the 2100 block of Abbottsbury Way in Woodbridge (22191) for a juvenile suffering a mental health crisis. Officers initially located the juvenile walking in the area of Potomac Club Pkwy and Richmond who immediately fled on foot and later returned to his home in the above area. When officers made contact with the juvenile at his residence, he brandished two large kitchen knives and began making threats to the officers. At one point during the encounter, the accused held a knife to the throat of an adult family member who was eventually safely evacuated from the home after initially being stopped by the accused. Officers entered the home as the accused barricaded himself in an upstairs room. Officers contained the incident and evacuated nearby homes as a precaution. Several resources responded to the scene to de-escalate the situation, including a negotiator and social worker. Eventually, the accused exited the home where he was detained without further incident and transported to a medical facility for further evaluation. Following the investigation, charges were obtained against the accused, a **16-year-old male juvenile**, who currently remains hospitalized for treatment.

Abduction of a Minor – On May 22 at 9:40PM, officers responded to the Summerhouse II Condos located in the 13500 block of Cridercrest Pl in Woodbridge (22191) to assist Fredericksburg Police with an ongoing investigation into a missing juvenile. Officers arrived at the residence and safely located the 17-year-old female juvenile in the custody of the suspect who was also being sought by Fredericksburg authorities. The suspect was detained without incident, and the juvenile was reunited with her family. Following the investigation, Prince William County detectives subsequently arrested the accused, identified as Ronnie Keane **REEL**. Strong-Arm Robbery – On May 23 at 7:10PM, an officer was working an off-duty detail at the Walmart located at 8386 Sudley Rd in Manassas (20109) when they were advised of a shoplifting-in-progress. The investigation revealed an unknown man, later identified as the accused, concealed merchandise inside the store before being confronted by a store employee. During the encounter, the accused pushed the employee and left the business where the officer also attempted to stop him. The accused continued to flee towards Sudley Rd where he was able to flag down a passing vehicle for a ride. The vehicle was located a short time later and the accused was detained without further incident. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Michael Corenelius **WILLIAMS**, was arrested.
