

NOTICE OF WILLINGNESS

North Woodbridge Pedestrian Bridge Project

The Prince William County Department of Transportation (PWC DOT) invites you to review information about the North Woodbridge Pedestrian Bridge Project (Project). The proposed improvements are located along Richmond Highway (US Route 1) between Occoquan Road/Dawson Beach Road and Gordon Boulevard (Route 123). The Project includes the design and construction of a pedestrian bridge across a six-lane roadway section of Route 1. Pedestrian access between the proposed North Woodbridge Town Center, the Woodbridge Virginia Railway Express (VRE) Station, and current pedestrian facilities throughout the Route 1/Occoquan Road/Dawson Beach Road intersection is made possible by additional Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant shared-use paths and sidewalk connections to and from the bridge.

Pursuant with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and 23 CFR 771, a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion (PCE) has been prepared under agreement with the Federal Highway Administration for this project.

If, upon receiving public comments, it is deemed necessary to hold a public hearing, notice of date, time and location of the hearing will be posted to the previously listed website.
