Prince William 4-H Clubs provide a place where youth can belong and grow!

4-H Clubs are open to youth ages 5-19 and can meet in school, after school, or independently—led by teachers or volunteers. Built on the 4-H Beyond Ready model, youth gain the skills they need today to thrive tomorrow—developing confidence, leadership, and real-world readiness through hands-on learning and mentorship. Programs focus on the core pillars of Citizenship, Healthy Living, Agriculture, and STEM, with opportunities ranging from animal science and environmental education to leadership, financial literacy, and creative arts. Along the way, youth build portfolios, explore career pathways, and connect their interests to future goals.

Through 4-H, young people compete, give back through service, attend camps, lead their peers, and discover their spark in a supportive, inclusive community. 4-H is for everyone!



START A 4-H CLUB IN 4 EASY STEPS

- 1. GET STARTED.** Contact Prince William 4-H and attend the September adult leadership training.
- 2. SPREAD THE WORD.** Share the 4-H experience, invite families, and recruit volunteers to help lead
- 3. LAUNCH YOUR CLUB.** Hold meetings—choose a name, set a schedule, plan projects, and elect youth leaders.
- 4. KEEP IT GROWING.** Meet regularly, stay connected, celebrate achievements, serve your community, and join 4-H events at every level.
