- ✓ **BEVERAGE CANS**
- ✓ **PLASTIC BOTTLES (EMPTY, CLEAN, AND DRY)**
- ✓ **CARDBOARD PACKAGING (FLATTENED)**



 **DON'T RECYCLE THESE**

- ✗ **FIREWORKS (USED OR UNUSED)**
- ✗ **PARTY DECORATIONS (STREAMERS, PLASTIC TABLECLOTHS)**
- ✗ **PAPER PLATES, NAPKINS, AND PLASTIC UTENSILS**

 **THESE ITEMS BELONG IN THE TRASH, NOT THE RECYCLING BIN!**

 **TIP: IF IT'S DIRTY, WET, OR MADE OF MIXED MATERIALS, IT'S NOT RECYCLABLE.**

 **WHEN IN DOUBT, THROW IT OUT!**

Firework Disposal

- Soak used, dud, or unused fireworks fully overnight.
- After soaking, double-wrap in plastic bags and dispose in trash.
- Store any unused fireworks in a cool, dry place, away from children and electrical sources.
