Hypothermia Services

Hypothermia Shelter Services are provided in the Prince William Area from November 1 to March 31. These services aim to prevent the loss of life or limb due to extreme cold weather conditions.

Hypothermia services operate on the East side and West side of the county. East hypo is open nightly during hypothermia season and West hypo is open only based on weather during hypothermia season.

Identification: Each person in the household (spouse, children, parents, etc.) must provide ID that includes the individual's date of birth. ID can be from any country. Examples include valid driver's license, Valid passport, birth certificate, valid state-issued ID, picture ID, valid student ID.

Proof of Address: Examples include current utility bill or some form of "official mail," voter registration card, USPS change of address confirmation.

Food is distributed twice a month (every 15 days). Education classes are offered with our partners who can also assist with the associated costs.

📌 The Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) is a U.S. government program that helps many low-income households with discounts for internet service and equipment costs. Prince William area residents can call or text their address to determine eligibility.

Eligibility criteria includes household income below 200% of the Federal Poverty Line, or if someone in the household currently receives a government benefit such as SNAP, Medicaid, SSI, WIC, Pell grant or free and reduced-price lunch.
