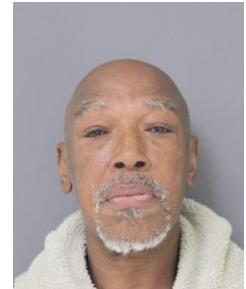
Aggravated Malicious Wounding *ADDITIONAL ARREST- The suspect sought in connection with the aggravated malicious wounding that was reported to have occurred in the 15900 block of Donald Curtis Dr in Woodbridge (22191) on February 21 was arrested. On May 29, the accused, identified as Ezekiel **COOPER III**, was taken into custody by officers without incident.

Arrested on May 29:

Ezekiel **COOPER III**, 62, of Woodbridge

Charged with **malicious wounding**

Aggravated Malicious Wounding [Previously Released]- On February 21 at 7:15PM, officers responded to the 15900 block of Donald Curtis Dr on Woodbridge (22191) to investigate an assault. The investigation revealed the victim, a 29-year-old man, was at the bus stop when he was assaulted by three unknown men, two of which were later identified as the two accused. The victim was transported to an area hospital with serious, non-life-threatening injuries. Following the investigation, officers obtained arrest warrants for the two accused, identified as Deashon Thomas **CLARK** and Ezekiel **COOPER III**. On February 21, Deashon Thomas **CLARK** was arrested. Attempts to locate Ezekiel **COOPER III** were unsuccessful.

Incidents

Malicious Wounding- On May 31 at 7:30PM, officers responded to the Exxon service station, located at 8289 Sudley Rd in Manassas (20109) to investigate an assault. The investigation revealed the victim, a 45-year-old man, and two acquaintances were standing outside the business when they were approached by an unknown man. During the encounter, the suspect became aggressive, produced a machete and swung it at the victim, striking him in the hand, before leaving the area on a bicycle. The victim was treated at an area hospital. The suspect was described as a Hispanic male wearing a white shirt, blue jeans and a reggae-style hat,

Strong-Armed Robbery- On May 31, officers responded to investigate a robbery that was reported to have occurred in the area of Richmond Hwy and Featherstone Dr in Woodbridge (22191) on May 30 at 9:00PM. The investigation revealed the victim, a 33-year-old man, was at the bus stop when he was approached by two unknown men. During the encounter, the suspects assaulted the victim and searched his person for money, before leaving the area on foot. Minor injuries were sustained by the victim.

Suspect descriptions:

Black male, aged late teens to early 20's, thin, wearing black clothing and white and black shoes

Hispanic male, aged late teens to early 20's. heavyset with curly hair and wearing a white shirt

Vandalism- On May 31, officers responded to the 14100 block of Page St in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a vandalism that was reported to have occurred between May 29 at 12:00AM and May 31 at 2:00PM. The investigation revealed during that timeframe, swastikas and derogatory lettering were spray painted onto a utility box. No additional markings were located, and no suspect description was available.

Arrests

Shooting into an Occupied Dwelling- On May 31 at 6:35PM, officers responded to the Landing at Mason's Bridge Apartments, located in the 13100 block of Mason's Bridge Rd in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a shots fired call. The investigation revealed two men were involved in a physical altercation in the breezeway of the apartment complex. During the encounter one of the men, later identified as the accused, pointed a firearm in the air and fired one gunshot through the third floor of the breezeway. No injuries or other property damage were reported. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Rashaan Hassien-Hameed **EDWARDS**, was arrested.

Charged with **shooting into an occupied dwelling, reckless handling of a firearm, brandishing, possession of a firearm while under a protective order, carrying a concealed firearm** and **intoxicated in public.**

Court date: **Pending** | Status: **\$15,000 Secured**

Armed Robbery- On May 29, officers responded to investigate a robbery that was reported to have occurred in the 10900 block of Coverstone Dr in Manassas (20109) at 10:15PM. The investigation revealed the victim, a 17-year-old male juvenile, was operating his minibike when he was approached by an unknown man, later identified as the accused. During the encounter, the accused pointed a firearm at the victim, demanded the minibike, and subsequently left the area on the minibike. No injuries were reported. A short time later, officers located the accused operating the minibike and quickly took him into custody. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Darby Jermaine **MACON** Jr, was arrested.
