Incidents

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On June 1, officers responded to a residence located in the 14400 block of Aden Rd in Nokesville (20181) to investigate a shots fired call. The investigation revealed sometime overnight, the garage door to the home was struck by gunfire. No injuries or other property damage were reported, and no shell casings were located.

Commercial Burglary- On June 2 at 12:17AM, officers responded to the Hippie House Smoke Vape and Gift, located at 8103 Centreville Rd in Manassas (20111) to investigate a burglary. The investigation revealed an unknown man gained entry into the business by shattering the front door with a cinderblock. Once inside the business, the suspect stole multiple items of merchandise before leaving the area on foot. A Police K-9 searched the area for the suspect, who was not located. The suspect was described as a Hispanic male, thin build, wearing black clothing.

Unlawful Entry- On June 1, officers responded to the Sky Zone located at 14555 Potomac Mills Rd in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate an unlawful entry. The investigation revealed at 2:34AM, three juvenile males entered the business through the roof hatch. Once inside the business, the suspects jumped on the trampolines before leaving the area on foot. No items were reported stolen and no property damage was reported. The suspects were described as two male juveniles wearing dark clothing and one male juvenile wearing red shorts.

Arrests

Sexual Battery- On May 31, officers responded to investigate a sexual assault that was reported to have occurred at Rosa Parks Elementary School, located at 13446 Princedale Dr in Woodbridge (22193) at 3:15PM. The investigation revealed the victim, a 14-year-old male juvenile, was playing basketball when he was approached by an unknown man, later identified as the accused. The accused asked the victim to play basketball and during the encounter, the accused inappropriately touched the victim before forcibly pushing him to the ground. Minor injuries were reported by the victim. Following the investigation, officers obtained charges and the accused, identified as Timothy Michael **BANGURA**, was arrested.



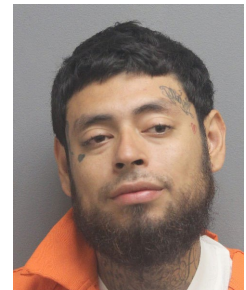

Attempted Carjacking- On June 1 at 6:40AM, officers responded to the Walmart located at 14000 Worth Ave in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate an attempted carjacking. The investigation revealed the victim, a 44-year-old woman, was in her vehicle when she was approached by an unknown man, later identified as the accused. During the encounter the accused, who was found to be intoxicated, repeatedly pulled on the door handle and told the victim to get out of the car. The victim refused and was able to safely drive away from the accused. The accused then attempted to assault an employee and was later taken into custody by responding officers. No injuries were reported. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Miguel Angel **VASQUEZ RIVERA**, was arrested.
