Incidents

Death Investigation- On June 5 at 4:27PM, officers responded to the parking lot of Potomac Mills, located at 2700 Potomac Mills Cir in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a report of an unconscious individual. The investigation revealed the individual, identified as a 22-year-old man, was located unconscious in a vehicle. The man was transported to an area hospital and later pronounced deceased. Preliminarily, there were no signs of foul play or threat to the community concerning the death. More information regarding the investigation will be released if deemed necessary.

Sexual Assault Investigation- On June 5, officers responded to the Food Lion, located at 14641 Richmond Hwy in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a sexual assault that was reported to have occurred on June 2 at 5:28PM. The investigation revealed the victim, an employee of the business, was standing near the hot food bar when an unknown man inappropriately touched her. No injuries were reported by the victim. The suspect was described as a white male, tall, with shoulder length brown hair, short beard, and hazel eyes, wearing a blue hat, green jacket, black t-shirt, blue sweatpants and light-colored tennis shoes.

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On June 5, officers responded to a residence located in the 9700 block of Willman's Way in Manassas (20111) to investigate a report of shots fired. The investigation revealed that sometime between May 31 at 2:00AM and June 5 at 12:27AM, the side of the home was struck by gunfire. No injuries or other property damage were reported, and no shell casings were located.

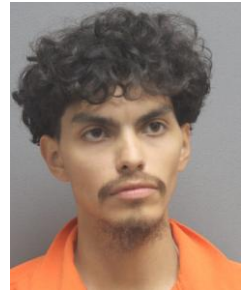

Arrests

Malicious Wounding- On June 7 at 3:00AM, officers responded to the 1400 block of E St in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate an assault. The investigation revealed the victim, a 28-year-old man, was walking home with three acquaintances when he became involved in a physical altercation with two unknown men, one of which was later identified as the accused. During the altercation, the accused brandished a firearm and struck the victim with it. The victim sustained injuries and was treated by medics. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Eris **ARRIAZA REYES**, was arrested. The other assailant involved was also taken into custody and charged with assault & battery.



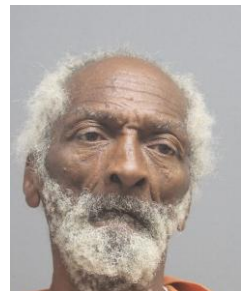

Assault and Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]- On June 5 at approximately 11:54AM, officers responded to the Wawa located at 15809 Richmond Hwy in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a report of a trespasser. The investigation revealed an individual, identified as the accused, was at the business after having previously been served trespassing paperwork. The accused left the location on foot prior to police arrival. Officers located the accused a short distance away on Donald Curtis Dr, determined he had multiple outstanding arrest warrants, and took him into custody. During a custodial search the accused became agitated and kicked an officer twice. No injuries were reported by the officer. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Stevie **DRUMMONDS**, was arrested.

Assault and Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]- On June 6 at 5:04PM, officers responded to the 3926 Forge Dr in Woodbridge (22193) for a report of a disorderly individual. The investigation revealed the individual, identified as the accused, was found by officers in an intoxicated, and was detained. As officers attempted to take the accused into custody, a struggle ensued and the accused kicked an officer, before being secured. While being seated inside the police cruiser, the accused again kicked the officer and damaged the officer's equipment. No injuries were reported by the officer. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Carlos Osmin **GARCIA**, was arrested.
