Aggravated Malicious Wounding *ARREST- The suspect sought in connection with the aggravated malicious wounding that was reported to have occurred in the 3600 block of Jurgensen Dr in Triangle (22172) On February 27, 2025, was arrested. On May 17, the accused, identified as Cecilia Anne **KEEFER**, was taken into custody by Stafford County Sheriff's Office.

Aggravated Malicious Wounding [Previously Released] – On February 27 at 2:02AM, officers responded to the Linden Park Apartments located in the 3600 block of Jurgensen Dr. in Triangle (22172) to investigate an assault. The investigation revealed the victim, a 23-year-old woman, and an acquaintance, identified as the accused, were involved in a verbal altercation that escalated. During the encounter, the accused struck the victim several times while both parties were inside a vehicle. At one point, the victim exited the vehicle and was struck by the vehicle before the accused drove off. The victim was treated at an area hospital for non-life threatening injuries. Following the investigation, officers obtained arrest warrants for the accused, identified as Cecilia Anne **KEEFER**. Attempts to locate the accused have been unsuccessful.

Armed Robbery- On June 9 at 7:40PM, officers responded to the 7-Eleven, located at 8211 Old Centreville Rd in Manassas (20111) to investigate a robbery. The investigation revealed the victim, a 40-year-old man, was inside his vehicle at the above location when he was approached by two unknown men. During the encounter, the suspects brandished a firearm, demanded money and assaulted the victim, before leaving the area in a blue sedan. The victim sustained minor injuries and was treated by medics. The suspects were described as a black male wearing black clothing and a Hispanic male wearing a grey sweatshirt and armed with a handgun.

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On June 9, officers responded to a residence located in the 10000 block of Ellis Rd in Manassas (20111) to investigate a shots fired call. The investigation revealed that at approximately 2:00AM that morning, a vehicle driving down Ellis Rd fired multiple gunshots, before leaving the area. Multiple shell casings were recovered along the roadway. No injuries or property damage were reported. No suspect description was available.
