### Incidents

**Reckless Handling of a Firearm-** On June 11 at 11:52PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 3000 block of Vidalia Ct in Dumfries (22026) to investigate a call for shots fired. The investigation revealed the homeowners were on the porch when they observed two unknown men walking in the area. When the homeowners called out to the men, one of the suspects fled between nearby houses, and a gunshot was heard immediately after. After the gunshot, the second suspect fled the area on foot. The following morning, a bullet hole was located in the garage door of the home and additional damage was located on the side of a neighboring residence. No injuries were reported and no shell casings were located. No suspect description was provided.

**Attempted Residential Burglary-** On June 12, officers responded to a residence located in the 2000 block of Sequoia Ct in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate an attempted burglary that was reported to have occurred on June 11 at approximately 4:00AM. The investigation revealed an unknown man was observed looking through the window to the residence, before leaving the area on foot. The next morning, the homeowner discovered the screen to the window had been cut. No items were reported missing and no additional property damage was reported. The suspect was described as a male wearing a black hoodie.
