Incidents

Homicide Investigation- On June 15 at 9:57PM, officers responded to the area of Old Centreville Rd and Parkland St in Manassas (20111) to investigate a report of shots fired. During the initial investigation, officers determined a shooting occurred in the nearby Bull Run Mobile Home Community, in the area of Peppertree Ln and Pebble Ln. The investigation revealed the victim, an 18-year-old man, was in the area when he was shot in the upper body. Following the encounter, the victim attempted to leave the area and collapsed in the backyard of a nearby residence on Parrish Ln. Officers located the victim, attempted life-saving measures and ultimately, the victim was pronounced dead on scene. The suspects left the area and were not immediately located. Additionally, during the investigation a residence located in the 7400 block of Peppertree Ln was found to be struck by gunfire. **Preliminarily, this incident does not appear to be random. Detectives are asking anyone with any information, or anyone who may have witnessed the incident, to contact police.** Additional information will be released when available. The investigation continues.

Vehicle Pursuit | Felony Eluding- On June 15 at 9:54PM, officers responded to a 14900 block of Feeder Ln in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a domestic dispute. The investigation revealed the victim, a 34-year-old woman, was assaulted, abducted and robbed by a family member identified as the accused. The victim sustained injuries and was transported to an area hospital for treatment. Officers obtained multiple arrest warrants for the accused and were actively attempting to locate him throughout the night. On June 16 at 05:38AM, officers were notified the accused was at the hospital where the victim was receiving treatment and was threatening to enter the hospital. Officers located the accused in the hospital parking lot, operating a blue Nissan Rogue and attempted to conduct a traffic stop. The accused refused to stop the vehicle and officers initiated a pursuit. The pursuit continued onto I-95 North and the accused struck a jersey barrier, before exiting I-95 onto Fullerton Rd in Springfield. Due to safety concerns, the pursuit was terminated and area agencies were notified. Following the investigation, officers obtained additional arrest warrants for the accused, identified as Tariq Kamal **RASHEED**. Attempts to locate Tariq Kamal **RASHEED** were unsuccessful.

Wanted for one count of **felony eluding**, one count of **malicious wounding**, one count of **robbery**, on count of **abduction**, two counts of **child neglect**, one count of **domestic assault & battery**, one count of **unauthorized use of a vehicle** and one count of **reckless driving**.

Vandalism on School Grounds- On June 11, the School Resource Officer (SRO) assigned to Forest Park High School located at 15721 Forest Park Dr in Woodbridge (22193) was notified of vandalism that occurred in a classroom. The investigation revealed sometime during the school year, multiple swastikas were drawn on an eraser that was used communally in the classroom. No additional lettering or images were located, and school personnel removed the item.
